Mounties Clamber Into 1st

Three doubleheaders shuffled up the first division teams of the Pacific Coast League Sunday, putting Vancouver back into a first-place tie with Sacramento.

Portland dropped from second to take Vancouver's spot in a third-place tie with Salt Lake City.

Vancouver trounced the Bees, 7-3, in the opener at Salt Lake City, then edged them, 5-4, in the nightcap. Wes Stock went all the way on the mound for the Mounties in the opener and veteran Marv Palfica pitched the second game.

Seattle and Sacramento split on the Solons' grounds. Sacramento took the second game, 2-9, after a 9-1 trouncing by the Rainiers in the first one. Bob Mabe held the Solons to three hits and Carl Greene came back to shut out Seattle on four.

San Diego scored an even dozen runs, dividing them evenly between the two halves of a doubleheader with Portland. The Padres beat the Beavers, 6-3 and 6-5.

Carl Thomas notched his third mound victory of the season for San Diego in the opener and reliever Jake Striker got his sixth win in the nightcap.

Vancouver's Stock recorded his second victory in holding Salt Lake to three hits—two singles and a triple. He gave up a single to Sam Miley in the first and another to Chuck Harmon in the seventh. Carlos Bernier's triple drove Harmon home. Miley was three-for-four in the second game, but it didn't help as the Mounties got enough runs in the first two innings. Back-to-back doubles started the winners on a four-run first. A homer by Jim Baumer brought in one Bee run.

Lou Skizas hit a two-run homer for Seattle in the first inning of the opener and started the Rainiers on their way. In the nightcap, Bob Roselli's home run and a tally pushed in without a hit gave the Solons their edge.

Portland's George Friesse had a big night at bat in the doubleheader at San Diego, collecting three home runs to bring his season total to 15. Steve Jankowski hit a home run for the Padres in the opener and then forced the nightcap into an extra inning with his bases-loaded single that tied it all up.
