**Butte Valley Fair Planned**

**TULELAKE**—A new method of selecting the queen of the Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair to be held September 12, 13 and 14, was announced today by Russell Smith, fair director in charge of the queen's contest.

This year the reigning monarch will be chosen not on the basis of the number of tickets she sells, but on her qualifications in beauty, which will count 40 per cent; popularity, 25 per cent; personality, 20 per cent and talent, 15 per cent.

The results will be announced at the annual queen's ball on Monday, September 7 in the Home Economics Building at the Fairgrounds. Popularity will be judged by a vote cast by each person attending the dance, for the candidate he thinks would serve as the best queen.

Qualifications for each contestant include that she must be 16 by September 1 and that she may not have reached her 25th birthday by August 30. She must also reside in Butte Valley, the Tulelake Basin, Merrill or Malin. Thus, a California girl will be eligible for the Maid of California contest next fall.

Further regulations state that a girl may not be married, and that she must have entered her application form at the fair office by August 12 at 5 p.m. Applications are available at the grounds and at the First Western Bank, Dorris.

If a participant is younger than 21, her parents must sign the petition. She need not be sponsored by any organization or group of people, but may apply to the fair board on her own merits. Several have expressed interest in the program.

**Iraqi Strikes At Communists**

**BEIRUT, Lebanon (AP)**—Iraqi Premier Abdel Karim Kassem carried his campaign to contain communism in his country two steps farther Wednesday.

Without mentioning them by name, he accused the Reds of planning simultaneous uprisings in all major Iraqi cities on July 14, the anniversary of the Iraqi revolution.

Kassem's government also ordered members of the Popular Resistance Force, a Communist-dominated militia, not to wear their uniforms and said the force's duties had been abolished.
