Water Shortage Not Threat Now

PORTLAND (AP)—An expected summer water shortage in the Columbia Basin has not materialized, the Department of Interior said Saturday.

The Columbia streamflow at The Dalles during July was 132 per cent of the 15-year July average. In eight major power reservoirs, water storage was more than four million acre feet above the season average for the past 10 years during July.

Storage in 20 large irrigation reservoirs was well above the seasonal average, but 402,000 acre feet less than a year ago.

Explorer I, launched Jan. 31, 1958, with an expected space lifetime of five years.

Vanguard I, launched March 17, 1958, with an estimated space lifetime of 200 years or more.

Explorer IV, launched July 28, 1958, with a space lifetime of one year, two months. It is expected to fall about Sept. 17 of this year.

Vanguard II, launched Feb. 17, 1959, with an estimated space lifetime of more than 100 years.

Explorer VI, launched Aug. 7, 1959, with an estimated space lifetime of more than a year.

The artificial planet, Pioneer IV, was launched March 3, 1959, and has a space lifetime measured in millions of years.

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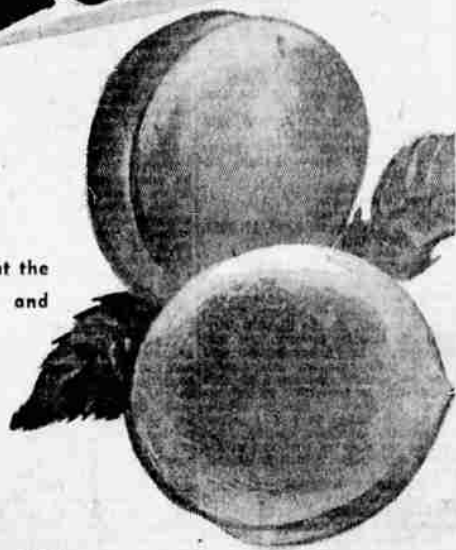
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
