

Elder To Give 'Homecoming' Church Talk

Church of the Latter Day Saints will offer a special program Sunday, August 23, at 7 p.m., when Elder Eugene H. Metler, son of Mr. and Mrs. Everett Metler, 5122 Bryant Street, will give a homecoming speech. He is returning from two and one-half years in missions in New Mexico and Texas.

Metler is the first of four Klamath Falls boys to participate in the church's project of sending young men to full-time missions for two or three years. They fill positions in needy areas of the U.S. and foreign countries. The boys

receive no wages, so they must go by supporting themselves or by aid from their parents or the church.

The other young Mormon missionaries participating in this program are Larry Phair, who works in France and Belgium, and his brother, Gary, who is in Uruguay. They are the sons of Ronald Phair, 4850 Shasta Way. Ray Behnke is the other student, and he is stationed in northern Mexico. Mr. and Mrs. Basil Behnke, 3347 Homedale Road, are his parents.

Metler graduated from Klamath Union High School in 1954 and attended Brigham Young University at Provo for two years before beginning his church assignment. He first went to Albuquerque, then to San Antonio, and from there to Dallas where he served as district president over eight full-time missionaries. He also organized a branch of the church for all Spanish speaking people.

The student will arrive home with his sister, Marilyn, who is presently attending the University of Utah summer school. In the fall both young people will return to their prospective colleges.

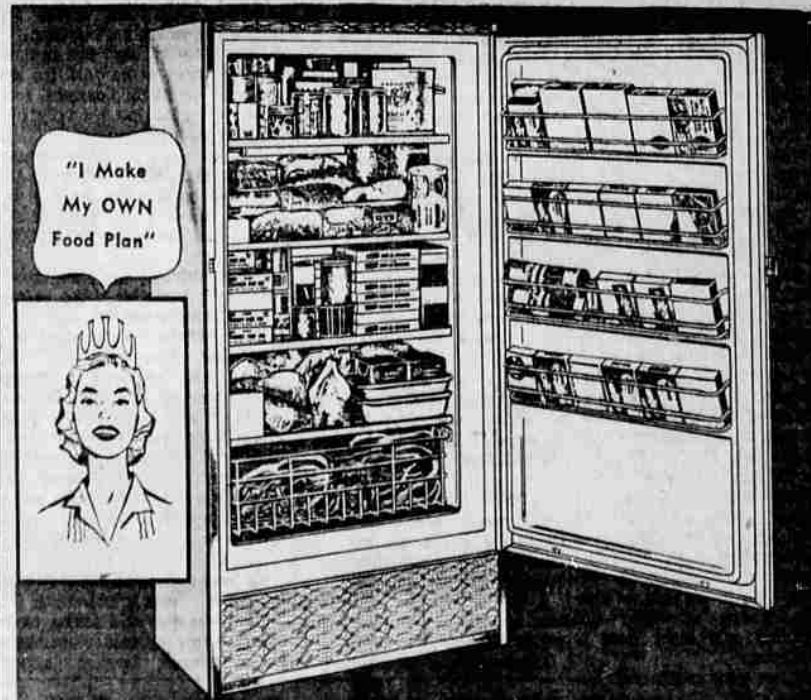

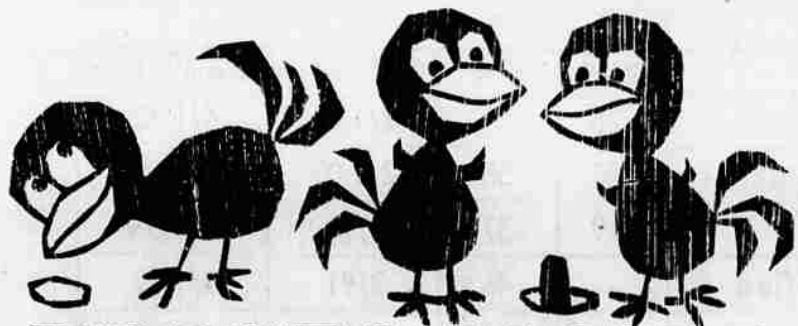
