

### Local Student Seeks Post As College League Chief

Fred W. Heard, assistant chairman of the Oregon Republican Federation of Oregon and chairman of the University of Oregon Young Republicans, recently announced that he would be a candidate for

state chairman of the College League at the state convention, set for Eugene, this fall.

Heard, who lives here, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Darrell L. Heard. He will be a sophomore in political science at the university.

In 1956 he started participation in Republican politics when he was selected to be chairman of the Youth For Eisenhower for Klamath County. He later organized a Klamath County Young Republican Society, served as chairman two years; was selected to be one of Klamath County's first state board representatives; was one of four young GOPs to attend the 1957 inauguration of President Eisenhower and during the 1958 primary election in Oregon he served as county chairman for State Treasurer Sig Unander in his bid for the gubernatorial nomination.

Heard served also as summer publicity director for Mark Hatfield's campaign for governor and

was director of the "United Republican Victory League," an organization formed to elect all Republicans in November 1958; chairmanned the 1958-1959 Klamath County Republican picnics. In his second term as chairman of the U of O Young Republicans, Heard states that his group is the first such organization in the nation to endorse possible candidacy of Vice President Richard M. Nixon for the 1960 presidential election.

U of O Young Republicans are scheduling visits at the university for state officials during the coming months.

Upon announcing his candidacy, Heard stated, "The months ahead will be both trying and short for the Republican party. I am convinced that with proper leadership and proper working team the College League can become a mighty working GOP political machine in Oregon. I have every confidence of election and support following the election."

### Timber Tracts Sale Reported

Two tracts of timber in southern Douglas County were sold August 13 for \$339,837 by the Medford District of the Bureau of Land Management. The tracts contained 11,278,000 board feet.

One tract on Whitehorse Creek near Azalea brought a high of \$44.20 for Douglas fir during the last sale.

The next bureau sale will contain 10,577,000 board feet of timber in Klamath County, district officials say. The sale will include a total of 16,060,000 feet. The remaining timber is in Jackson and Josephine counties.

## Ghostly Piper Said Sad, Say People In The Know

AYR, Scotland (AP) — People who knew about such things say the ghostly piper of Culzean Castle is sad. He doesn't think the time will be right to pipe if President Eisenhower comes for a visit to his Scottish home this month.

Within the walls of Culzean—pronounced Cullane—there's a spot known as the Piper's Brae. On the eve of a marriage of someone in the family founders of Culzean, the ghost piper plays, say the local Scots.

Workers at the castle confidently expect that when the President visits Britain late this month, he will turn the castle into a White House for at least a day or two. But they hold little prospect for a marriage during the visit, thus, the piper's sadness.

The castle caretakers are beating carpets, airing tapestries and are in a general flurry of excitement because of rumors that their "laird" is coming home.

In 1945, a modernized top floor apartment of 16 rooms was put at Ike's disposal for the rest of his life. The gesture was a token of Scotland's appreciation for his services as Allied supreme commander during World War II.

Year in, year out, it awaits him. Before his election to the presidency, he vacationed twice at Culzean Castle. Since then, his brother Milton, and a few friends have had holidays there.

Located on a towering cliff above the majestic sweep of the Firth of Clyde, Culzean lies about 15 miles south of Ayr and a few miles north of Turnberry.

The prospect of an Eisenhower visit has already begun to swell the ranks of tourists who daily troop through the castle, paying three shillings—42 cents—for the privilege. The price of admission, however, does not allow them to see Eisenhower's flat. That's strictly private.

The money goes to the National Trust, a government institution that looks after and preserves old houses and other national monuments.

"The American president will soon be coming here to stay, won't he?" asked a Scotswoman sight-seer. "Ah, is he now?" replied the caretaker, William Miller.

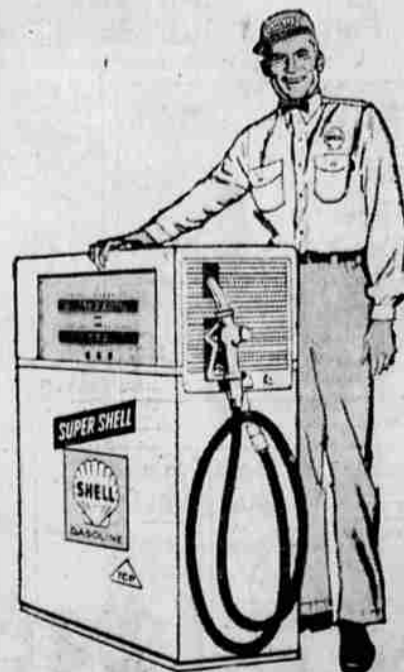
