



FOR A FANCY DESSERT, put date torte together with coffee-flavored whipped cream. For a simpler one, serve it plain cut into smaller sized pieces. This date torte, from the kitchens of the California Foods Research Institute, is a luscious combination of naturally sweet fresh California dates and nuts in a cake-like dessert.

Date Torte

"Mother's Date Torte" is a hand-me-down pet recipe that was served for many occasions. It's the kind of dessert that can be dressed up and served in two layers with coffee-flavored whipped cream, or served plain cut into smaller sized portions.

Fresh California dates, pecans, and brown sugar is a sweet, chewy combination that everybody likes. The dessert keeps well and can be prepared and stored to have on hand. Because of its versatility, "Mother's Date Torte" will be-

come one of your standby recipes.

MOTHER'S DATE TORTE

1½ cups fresh California dates
2 tablespoons soft butter or margarine
¾ cups brown sugar (packed)
2 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla
½ cup sifted all-purpose flour
½ teaspoon baking powder
¼ teaspoon salt
¾ cup chopped pecans
1 cup whipping cream
2 tablespoons sugar
1 to 2 tablespoons instant powdered coffee

Pit and cut dates into medium-size pieces. Cream butter and brown sugar together. Beat eggs and add to creamed mixture along with vanilla. Sift flour, baking powder and salt into creamed mixture; add dates and nuts and mix well. Turn into well-greased and floured 11½x7½ inch pan or 8-inch square pan. Bake in moderately slow oven (325 degrees) about 25 minutes for oblong pan

and about 35 minutes for square pan. Cool and cut into squares. Whip cream and blend in remaining sugar and coffee powder. Spoon onto squares of cake or put two squares together shortcake fashion with cream and serve, garnishing top with additional whipped cream and pitted whole dates, if desired. Makes 8 to 12 servings.

SKIP SKIMMING

It is not necessary to skim jelly during the boiling period. Pour completed jelly into glass and then, with a clean spoon, carefully skim the foam from the top. It saves time and saves jelly.

BUTTERMILK

For a cool summer drink, combine 1½ cups chilled buttermilk with 1½ cups chilled orange juice, 1 tablespoon lemon juice and 1-3 cup sugar. Stir until sugar is dissolved and serve in tall glasses. Buttermilk contains only 85 calories per cup.

KEEP COOL

Buttermilk acidity increases during storage. Use it as soon as possible after purchase. Buttermilk should be kept refrigerated to preserve its flavor. Use it as a base for Roquefort cheese dressing for salad and in many cooking recipes.

GOURMET TOUCH

Make chocolate cinnamon toast for a speedy treat for lunch or brunch. Mix together ½ cup cocoa, 5 tablespoons melted butter, 1 teaspoon cinnamon and 6 tablespoons sugar. Spread it on hot, crisp toast. Keep reserve pieces hot in the oven.

HOW TO DRESS BABY

If you find it difficult to put on baby's undershirt, try the expandable-neckline shirt invented by Carter's. The Jiffon neck opening is constructed so it may be put on over the head or over the feet and legs and into smooth-fitting regular shirt position. Just slip both your hands into the shirt, stretch the hands apart so that the shirt moves over baby's body with the palms closest to the body. Takes lot less pulling and pushing and is more comfortable for baby, too.

have solved the problem of shirts torn by pinning to the diapers. Note the Nevahind sleeve construction which is available in other garments, too (even Carter's men's T-shirts). The special design of the underseam eliminates chafing.

ABOUT BABY SHIRTS

Did you know there are 16 styles of baby shirts? Carter's makes different styles of baby shirts in many assorted colors, and different fabrics of the softest cotton-knit. Some are at the front, some snap-fasten, others pull-over the head or feet—some are sleeveless, some short, others are long sleeved—some have a warm double thickness of fabric over the tummy.

ABOUT TOWELS

A good extra-precautionary safety measure is offered in the double layer, yard square of soft cotton-knit terry toweling designed with a hood at one corner. The towel completely engulfs baby after the bath, making it safer and easier for mother to hold and dry the baby. The hood covers the head after the shampoo.

ABOUT SLEEPWEAR

A soft cotton-knit, the sleeping Hibernator has a two-way zipper for quick and easy changes. Handicuffs are made to flip over and cover the hands. Growth features at the shoulders and hemline allow the Hibernator to grow from birthsize to a three year size. In a variety of lightweight or warmer fabrics for summer and winter sleeping, the Hibernator keeps the baby protected from drafts without the need of a blanket.
