**Sales Tax Hiked In Pennsylvania**

HARRISBURG, Pa. (AP)—Gov. David L. Lawrence signed into law Thursday a measure raising Pennsylvania's sales tax from 3 1/2 per cent to 4 per cent. Exempt are food for home consumption; clothing, material used in the construction of foundations for machinery; maintenance supplies bought by charitable and similar nonprofit organizations; machinery; printing services; and repairs to equipment used directly in radio and television broadcasting.
