Her attendants, who wore frocks of aqua embroidered nylon net, were her sister, Mrs. Oakley Summers, matron of honor, and Joyce

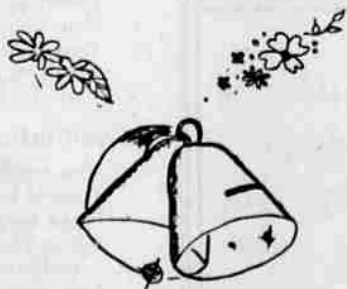
Bilton, bridesmaid. They carried bouquets of pink and white carnations. Flower girl Julie Mephram wore a pink nylon dotted Swiss dress.
