with difficulty as it bounced over the uneven pavement, dressed in the same tennis shoes and flowered print dress she had worn touring the countryside. She bowed humbly to the people with her extended palms pressed together under her chin in the custom of the country. The throng roared its approval.

I went back to the government house to bathe and catch my breath, later rejoining her, but Mrs. Roosevelt went on to several receptions and made speeches until nearly midnight with only a 15-minute respite to wash and change.

Again one afternoon upon our arrival in Karachi, India, while she was making a radio broadcast under difficult conditions at the airport, I fished a printed itinerary for her visit out of my pocket. I hadn't bothered to glance at it, assuming that our day was over, but it turned out her day was planned in careful 15-minute segments far into the evening. We had arisen that morning in the pre-dawn darkness and made a tortuous six-hour flight from Lydda airport in Israel, and Mrs. Roosevelt was looking forward to rest and a leisurely bath. But she wearily and determinedly fulfilled all her commitments because, as she said simply: "It is expected."

Then, as always, she did what she feels is "only my duty."

ONLY ONCE have I seen her arduous schedule even momentarily get the best of her. That was in Tashkent in Central Asia. We got up at 5 a.m. to fly to Samarkand, the fabulous capital of Tamerlane. When we got back to Tashkent at 7 that evening, worn out from walking in the heat all day, we were told a reception was planned for her. Mrs. Roosevelt had been on her feet for 14 hours and hadn't expected any evening activity, but she went through with it. But this time, it was too much for her. She fell quite ill and spent a sleepless night. The next morning, however, she insisted on continuing her trip at 5—a 2,000 mile flight in a Russian jetliner to Moscow.

Surprisingly enough for a woman whose public life seems to take more time than anyone has to give, Mrs. Roosevelt is very close to her family and makes time for them on a schedule that is booked many months in advance. Her children know that she is always available when they have a problem as do her grandchildren, great-grandchildren and friends.

During the summer, the whole Roosevelt clan and friends often picnic and swim together, and Mrs. Roosevelt joins in as enthusiastically as the youngsters. She not only swims in the pool at Hyde Park, but dives from the board, because, as she says: "I'm afraid of it, so it's good for my character."

It is this defiance of difficulty, perhaps

more than any other quality, that comes closest to the core of her being. The necessity to master many problems since her childhood has been her strength.

"I don't see why people go to psychiatrists when they have a problem," she says frankly. "If they faced up to it themselves, they'd be much stronger for it."

The key to her personality, her strength and her unending struggle for her fellow man is tied up with this philosophy of meeting problems head-on and defeating them. Most of the time, we see her as a woman of the world, poised and confident, but despite her seemingly gregarious nature and knack of handling any situation diplomatically, Mrs. Roosevelt was once ill-at-ease with people and, until this day, she carries a trace of this shyness. Nothing has come easily to her.

It would have been possible and comfortable, for Eleanor Roosevelt to remain in the shadows, but she felt it was her lot to serve. Because of this, her dedication, she is the busiest most active great-grandmother of our time.
