and Twelfth; Main and Pine between Sixth and Seventh, Eighth and Ninth and Tenth and Eleventh. An alley between Main and Pine and Fifth and Sixth was to be moved to the centerline of the alley.

Several other requests for lights were turned down upon recommendation of the three councilmen. Councilman Hoyt reported that all alley lights installed were for "police possession purposes" only.

THE POSSIBILITY of consolidation of the city and county street departments was discussed. Councilman Wynne had asked that a possible consolidation of the two be explored before the city proceed with construction of its own street department building.

Verzeer reported that the plan had been studied with the county shop superintendent and that after some discussion it was apparent that such consolidation was not possible at this time. He said, "The county shop has barely room enough for its own activities." Verzeer also pointed out that such a plan would involve a problem of control and authority and would be impractical for the city from the standpoint of the location of the present county shop.

Weyerhaeuser Company offered the city 1.53 acres of land which is adjacent to property at the south end of Spring Street which the city recently purchased from the State Highway Department as a site for a new street department building. After a discussion, the council moved to purchase the additional acreage for \$2,295.

THE QUESTION of jury trials in municipal court was also given an airing when City Attorney Perkins requested permission to draft a new ordinance which would change methods of selecting juries for such trials, and would make it possible for five out of six on the jury to return a verdict. He pointed out that the city charter had always provided for a jury trial providing the defendant requesting such trial first advanced \$30 to cover jury fees. If the defendant won the trial his money was returned.

When questioned if this would deny a jury trial to some, Perkins replied that the Supreme Court had ruled that municipal courts were extremely limited on the counts they could mete out, and that the court did not consider violation of an ordinance as a crime, thus the constitutional rights of a person to a trial by jury were not being denied.

Final reading was given to the massive new zoning ordinance which covers all areas of the city. The result of more than two years of study, the ordinance now is in effect.

A request by A. J. Honzel to permit paving of a parking strip at his residence, 315 Pacific Terrace, was referred to the city engineer's office. The council decided to study such a request in conjunction with a long range plan for the narrow Pacific Terrace street.

Councilman Fleet presided in the absence of Mayor Lawrence Slater.

Cold Wind Blows Over East U.S.

BY THE WEATHER PRESS Gusty winds blew cold air across wide areas in the eastern third of the country today but a warming trend developed in the nation's mid-section.

The cold air covered areas from the Great Lakes region to the lower Mississippi Valley and eastward to the Atlantic Coast. Highest temperature drops in the last 24 hours averaged near 20 degrees and were in the Ohio Valley and lower Great Lakes region.

Readings ranged from the 20s in the Great Lakes through the 30s extending southward into Virginia and Kentucky. The 40s and 50s prevailed in other areas southward, with the 60s near the Gulf Coast.
