SPRAY, SLAY WASPS

The safest way to kill wasps is by dusting or spraying the nests at least an hour after full darkness when the wasps are inside for the night. Comblike nests may be dusted with an insecticide containing 5 per cent chlordane or 5 to 10 per cent DDT. Paper-like globular nests of hornets or yellow jackets found in trees and shrubbery need a heavy dose of spray in their little opening. A flashlight should be used, if you need light on the job, but place it on the ground as wasps will come out and follow the light.

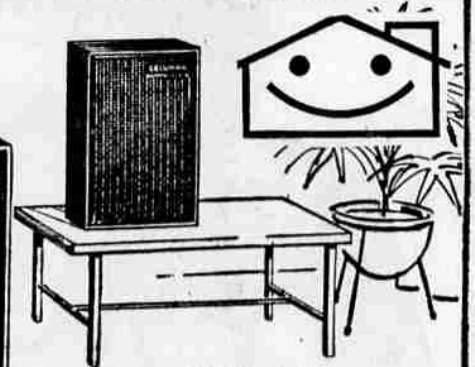
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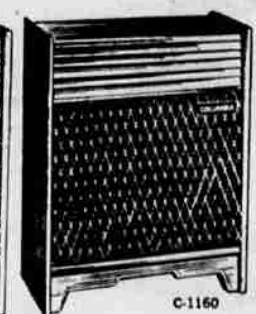
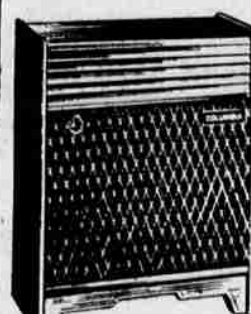
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
