West Blasted By Russians

MOSCOW (UPI)—The Soviet Union has accused the Western Powers of "fanning up the cold war" by establishing a new propaganda radio station in beleaguered West Berlin, it was learned today.

The official Soviet news agency Tass said the note, delivered to the U. S., French and British ambassadors Wednesday, protested the setting up of the freedom station by the West German government.

The note demanded that the Western Powers "take appropriate measures to preclude the possibility of such unlawful action." Tass reported.

The decision to establish the radio station was "unlawful since it is incompatible with the existing status of West Berlin," the note said.

(The State Department in Washington would say only that it had received a note from the Soviet Union and that it was under study. The department declined to disclose the contents there or the American reaction, pending further study.)

The Russian note is the newest denunciation by the Communists against western propaganda, notably via radio stations in West Berlin, which is disseminated behind the Iron Curtain.

Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev has frequently called propaganda efforts originating from West Berlin a "cancer" that must be "cut out."
