Traveling With The Chief: Afghanistan In Red Orbit

Editor's Note: This is one of a series of articles prepared by United Press International, depicting some of the political views and the general reception that President Eisenhower will receive in the various European countries he is scheduled to visit shortly.

Texas-bound Afghanistan leans further toward the Communist orbit than any other nation on President Eisenhower's list. Fifty per cent of its trade is with Russia—the figure was 10 per cent in 1950. Its 43,000-man army uses Russian equipment. Soviet engineers are building highways from the Russian border to Pakistan on a crash basis—Eisenhower will drive along one the Russians built.

The estimated 12 million Afghans, almost all Moslems, use fat from sheep's tails instead of butter, share seven movie theaters for the whole country, live by tribal law and the Vendetta.

The land that isn't mountain is likely to be desert. Not for nothing has Afghanistan been called "top of the world." Mountains 20,000 feet up and are a dime a dozen; in the west, winds as fierce as 130 mph blow almost continuously from June to September in temperatures ranging to 112 degrees. Mountain ranges split agricultural valleys. Most towns and villages are half-way up their sides.

Afghanistan's major industries produce matches and buttons and not much of those. Its farmers raise sheep, goats, camels and asafetida plants. Karacul is its lucrative export; the soil is fertile but only a slim percentage of it is cultivated. The nation's principal wealth is its immense flocks of sheep; mineral potential has never been explored, much less tapped.

King Mohammed Zahir Shah, 45, of Afghanistan is a constitutional monarch. Prime Minister Sadar Mohammad Daud, a professional army officer, doubles as defense minister and planning minister. Their capital is Kabul, a city of 210,000 a few miles downhill from the legendary Khyber Pass to Pakistan.

Afghanistan's problem is to move into the 20th Century. It will accept help from anybody to do so. Russia and the U.S. have competed to offer help; lately Russia has been winning.

The nation's women are still in purdah, only now losing the veil. Two million Afghans are nomads. There are no railways. Afghanistan is poor, proud and ambitious. Industrialization is planned but barely under way.
