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SWEET DIPS

The happy holiday season is the season to be jolly and to be "at home" to your friends. Snacks are a must on the list this time of year so why not try some sweet ones that the youngsters will like, too?

CAFE ORANGE DIP

Soften one 8-ounce package of cream cheese at room temperature. Stir in 1-3 cup orange juice, grated rind of one orange, 1 teaspoon instant coffee and 1 teaspoon lemon juice. This makes about 1 cup. Grated orange rind is a pretty garnish. Surround the bowl with a variety of small crackers such as Triangle Thins, Cheese Tid-Bits and Salt-Tang Snack Sticks or pretzels.

PINEAPPLE LEMON DIP

Cook two eggs with one can pineapple lemon concentrate until thick. Cool. Soften one 8-ounce package cream cheese at room temperature and mix with the egg mixture, beating until smooth. Makes about 2 cups. Sliced marshmallow cherries make a pretty garnish. Surround with assorted crisp crackers.

SNOWBALL

Blend four 3-ounce packages of softened cream cheese and 1/2 cup chopped chutney (or more if desired). Add at least two tablespoons brandy. Chill mixture. Shape into ball and roll in about 1 cup flaked coconut. Chill. Arrange on snack tray with raw vegetable sticks and crackers.

CARVER

Give the carver plenty of elbow room. Remove the water goblet and bread and butter or salad

bowl from his place setting before he begins on the holiday bird or roast. And be sure the carving knife is sharp.

MEAT RICE PIE

Hunt Foods, Inc., and General Foods' Minute Rice are joining forces to produce an unusual entrée which isn't much trouble to make and requires little time.

The Klamath County Cow Belles should like this recipe because ground beef makes the crust of the unusual pie.

CRUST

1/2 can (1/2 cup) Hunt's Tomato Sauce
1/2 cup bread crumbs
1 pound ground beef
1/4 cup chopped onion
1/4 cup chopped green pepper
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1/4 teaspoon oregano
1/4 teaspoon pepper

Combine ingredients. Mix well. Pat meat mixture into the bottom and sides of a well-greased 9-inch pie plate.

FILLING

1 1/2 cups Minute Rice
1 1/2 cans (1 1/2 cups) Hunt's Tomato Sauce
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 cup water
1 cup grated Cheddar Cheese

Combine Minute Rice, Hunt's Tomato Sauce, salt, water, 1/2 cup cheese. Spoon mixture into meat

shell. Cover with aluminum foil. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) 25 minutes. Uncover. Top with remaining cheese. Bake uncovered for about 10 to 15 minutes longer. Makes 5 or 6 servings.

BEEF RELISH

1 package lemon-flavored gelatin
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 cup hot water
1/4 cup cold water
1/4 cup vinegar
1/4 teaspoon salt
Dash of paprika
1 cup shredded lettuce
2-3 cups diced cooked beef
1 tablespoon chopped onion

Dissolve gelatin in 1/4 teaspoon salt in hot water. Add cold water, vinegar, and paprika. Chill until slightly thickened. Cook lettuce leaves in boiling salted water until tender. Drain and chill. Season beef with remaining 1/4 teaspoon salt; add onion and lettuce. Fold into slightly thickened gelatin. Pour into individual molds. Chill until firm. Unmold on crisp lettuce. Garnish with mayonnaise. Makes 6 servings.

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
