The family came to Klamath Falls in 1912 and lived here until 1927. During those years he continued as a pharmacist.

Thanksgiving Celebrated 340 Years Ago

On December 4, 1619, a tiny ship anchored in what is now the James River in Virginia. Debarking, the ship's 21 passengers knelt in prayer and celebrated the day as one of thanksgiving—possibly the first such observance in the New World.
Two years later the Pilgrims who landed at Plymouth set aside a day for thanksgiving and Massachusetts Bay Colony celebrated a thanksgiving day starting in 1636.
In 1863, President Lincoln designated the fourth Thursday in November as America's Thanksgiving Day.
The Englishmen who landed at the mouth of the James River in 1619 had sailed from their homeland September 16, 1619, to join the growing colony in Virginia. Their first order had read:
"Imp'r we ordaine that the day of our ships arrivall at the place assigned for plantacon in the land of Virginia shall be yearly and perpetually kept holy as a day of Thanksgiving to Almighty God."
Accounts survive of the ship's order and of the fact that the first Thanksgiving was celebrated. But whether it was commemorated from that year on is unknown.
An Indian massacre in 1622 wiped out the small settlement at Harrison's Landing, now the site of Berkeley Plantation, Virginia. The only survivor was a 12-year-old boy who was carried away by the Indians.
As near as can be figured, the ship was captained by John Woodliffe. His descendants claim that his orders, a copy of which is contained in the "Virginia Papers" described in the May, 1899, Bulletin of the New York Public Library, were given the captain by King James.

Neuberger Likes Adlai

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—Sen. Richard Neuberger (D-Ore.) says Adlai Stevenson is his choice for the Democratic nomination for president next year.
Stevenson twice has been his party's unsuccessful candidate.
Neuberger told a press conference here that Stevenson had told him he would "not spend a 4-cent stamp to get the nomination."
However, the senator said, Stevenson had implied that he would be available if there is a deadlock at the Democratic convention next year in Los Angeles.
"I believe there will be a deadlock," Neuberger said.
Neuberger also touched on Vice President Nixon and New York Gov. Nelson Rockefeller, generally considered the front runners for the Republican nomination.
At present, Neuberger said, Nixon "is so far ahead of the Republican nomination that Rockefeller can't communicate with him by smoke signals."
The United States foreign economic aid program will not survive unless President Eisenhower reverses his attitude toward domestic needs, Neuberger told the Democratic League of San Francisco.
In his speech, the senator said public opinion will not continue to support aid to underdeveloped nations when the administration refused to back essential domestic projects.
