**Gates Gives News Views**

WASHINGTON, (AP)—Secretary of Defense Thomas S. Gates Jr. says the Defense Department and all its officials have an obligation to see that the maximum amount of information is made public. He plans to hold news conferences at least every two weeks and says he will encourage the secretaries of the Army, Navy and Air Force to meet with newsmen and answer questions dealing with "factual" matters. Gates held his first news conference Wednesday a few hours after he was sworn in to succeed Neil H. McElroy as defense chief. McElroy had not met with reporters for several months before a farewell news conference Tuesday.

LANCASTER, Pa. (AP)—Lester Lehn had a little trouble getting the federal government to take his \$100. He gave the Treasury a rather original idea and they didn't know what to do. 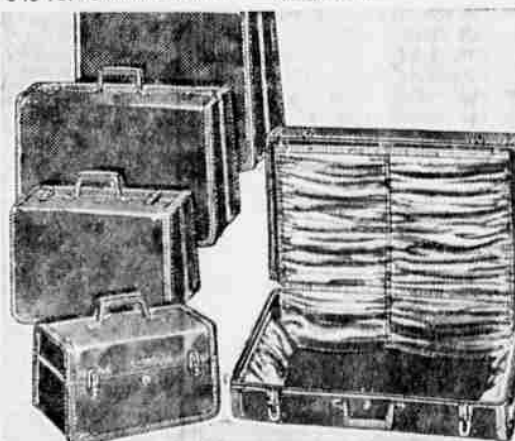

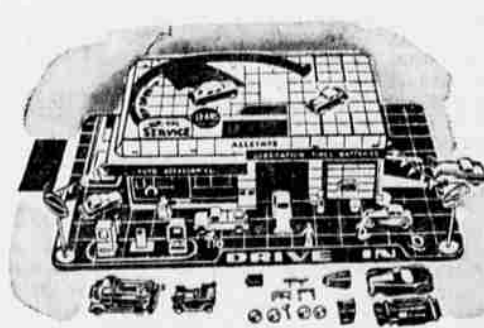
