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# Marciano Return Still Best Payday

NEW YORK (NEA)—Since he retired after knocking out Archie Moore four years ago, there have been numerous reports about Rocky Marciano coming back. Having been as close as the next one to The Rock and spent a full day with him after he announced he had quit, this department has been inclined to discount all such stories.

But when Norman Rothschild, most revolutionary of the younger promoters, tells you he is certain that Marciano will take another fling you have to listen.

"Marciano and Ingemar Johansson is by far the most attractive match in sight and that kind usually is made," said Rothschild while discussing his newly-launched continental cauliflower plan in the offices of the New York Boxing Commission.

Rothschild, who enjoyed phenomenal success in Syracuse, stepped out on the country promoting the

Gene Fullmer-Carmen Basilio midweight championship match in San Francisco, Aug. 25. Now he is sending Fullmer against Spider Webb in the field house of Utah State University at Logan, Dec. 4.

"Marciano and Johansson would gross at least four million dollars and that's a conservative estimate," stressed Rothschild, a bona fide one-time boy promoter just turned 40 and who hasn't an icy league suit or sincere necktie to his name, but knows the main art of mangling mugs. "They would do two million at the gate and more than double that on the later television. You understand how possible that would be when you consider the fact that Basilio and Ray Robinson did \$1,400,000 with theater TV."

"An equal share of that kind of money is hard for Marciano or anybody else to turn down, and I'm also fairly positive that Johansson would cut it right down the middle."

"When Marciano appeared at Carmen Basilio's Boxing Cavalcade at the New York State Fair in Syracuse, Sept. 4, I brought up the question of his fighting Johansson. Rocky has never stated positively that he would not come back.

"You missed the bus when you didn't get Floyd Patterson before Johansson, I told him by way of an opener. Patterson would have been a soft touch for you, and you were the one fellow who could have given him a tremendous payday."

"But now Johansson has set up an even bigger match for you. I'd like to have about five hours to talk it over with you."

"Norman," Marciano told Rothschild, "if you had five hours, you'd convince me."

Marciano, just turned 35, says he has no weight problem, contends he takes it off as easily as he puts it on. Having flopped in the potato business, he doesn't know what to do with himself and is strictly the prize ring type. He has been known to like money and there is plenty of that waiting for him if he elects to take a punch at Ingemar Johansson.

That's the principal reason Norman Rothschild is so sure that Rocky Marciano will return to what he did best.
