Chances are the youngsters will be lining up for their chance in the housekeeping corner. Even small boys love to cook at little stoves and iron with make-believe irons on small-size ironing boards.

The trend is to making these housekeeping appliances for children more like mother uses. There are laundry appliances that operate electrically, electric irons that are safety-tested, washing machines that wash. Dishwashers have motor pumps that swirl the water around. A three-foot-high electric oven and range can literally turn out baked goods that will rival mother's. One dishwasher and sink is battery operated. A motor pumps water into both sink and dishwasher.

A cooking package that insures fun with suds consists of a little bowl and heater, a package of soap, vegetable food colorings, and mixing equipment. Directions are included for making a nice gooey soapy frosting for a batch of cookies.

Any kind of jewelry is all right for Christmas—just so it's pearls. That's the word from the jewelry industry, whose members say they have never seen a season when pearls of all kinds, shapes and sizes, big and little, real and fake, have been in such demand.

Perhaps it's because this is a season when femininity and elegance have reached an all-time high — and pearls always have been favorites with great ladies, starting with Cleopatra, who not only wore them but is said to have swallowed them.

For Christmas giving and wearing, pearls are appearing in new sizes, shapes, finishes and colors, in new combinations and dramatic designs. Colored pearls are important in the holiday picture, ranging from fabulous cultured or oriental black pearls to costume pearls in tones of sable, smoke, jade, sapphire, burgundy, amber and gold. Often two or more shades of a color are blended for an effect of color gradation that is subtle and effective.

There are new finishes for costume pearls that would astonish an oyster. They range from a simulated cultured pearl finish to a dazzling white. Some pearls have a dull metallic gleam, and others a silky sheen.

As to sizes, you may choose anything from tiny seed pearls in multiple strands to jumbo pearls the size of marbles. There are many shapes, also—round, oval or flat.

Necklaces run the full gamut, from choker collars to long ropes. Sometimes pearls are paired with other gems or with gold or silver for a new look. Sparkling cut crystal combines with pearls with dramatic effect, as to jade, turquoise, emeralds or rubies, real or simulated.

Mending a finger piece of a glove? Slip a thimble inside to make sewing easier.

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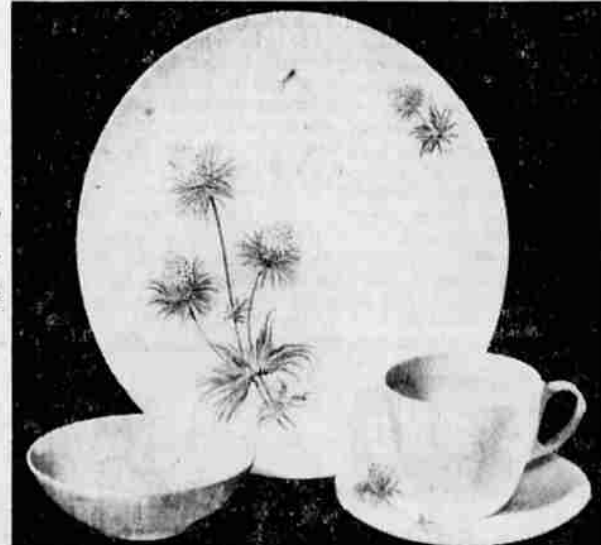


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
