Bowling Tournament In Last Half Finals

CHICAGO (AP)—The World Invitational Bowling Tournament moved into the last half of the final rounds today with Billy Golembiewski, a 30-year-old pro, in the top spot.

Golembiewski, a member of the ABC champion Pfeifers team of Detroit, was the big gun in Wednesday's firing in the \$30,000 tournament in the Chicago Coliseum.

Sixteen more games are scheduled today and the final 16 on Friday, with part of the shooting to be nationally televised Friday night, 10 p.m. CST, (NBC).

Golembiewski vaulted from third place into the lead with spectacular shooting. He averaged nearly 240 as he won 12 of 16 games in the second day of match competition. He was the leader in all categories, games won, pinfall and points.

Billy G., as the fans call him, was red-hot in the final four games Wednesday night, sweeping the series from Billy Welu of St. Louis with a 903 series on games of 215, 237, 224 and 227. Welu, all-star champion from St. Louis, posted 736.

Golembiewski, with 21½ games won and 10½ lost, had 161.40 Petersen points. In the first 32 games he knocked down 7,015 pins for an average of 219 per game.

In second place was Ray Bluth of St. Louis who won 12 of 16 games as he moved from eighth place to runnerup. He had 21 wins and 11 losses and 159.33 points.

Lou Frantz of Louisville, Ky., the leader after the first 16 games, dropped to third with a 20-12 won-lost record and 134.41 points. He won 7 games and lost 9 Wednesday.

In the women's division, Mrs. Olga Gloor, 39-year-old Chicago housewife, held her lead as she continued her sensational shooting. She has won 12 games and lost four, has 79.03 points and has averaged 209 for 16 games. The women bowl only eight games a day.

Closest to Mrs. Gloor was Donna Zimmerman, a 26-year-old typist from Akron, Ohio, who had 74.35 points and was averaging a shade under 203, and Robbie Frey, an attractive 35-year-old redhead from Dallas, who was third with 73.40 points.

Veep Sings Praises Of 'Atomic' Bill Cannon

NEW YORK (AP)—Billy Cannon, Louisiana State's All America halfback, heads back to Baton Rouge today, taking with him the accolades of Vice President Richard M. Nixon who presented him with the Heisman Trophy Wednesday night.

"He may not be the best runner, kicker, passer, tackler or pass receiver," Nixon told a nationwide radio audience and hundreds assembled at the Downtown Athletic Club, "but Billy Cannon is the best football player in the United States today."

Nixon described him as "not an ordinary Cannon, but an atomic Cannon—the ultimate weapon in the arsenal of Paul Dietzel (LSU coach)."

One LSU official wondered aloud if Cannon will now be allowed to settle down and prepare for the Sugar Bowl game against Mississippi on New Year's Day.

He has already been honored as an All America halfback on The Associated Press' 1959 eleven, the second year in a row he made the

first team, and was picked as the nation's outstanding back in a poll of writers and broadcasters.

The Heisman Trophy is given each year to the outstanding football player in the nation by a vote of sportswriters and broadcasters in conjunction with the Downtown A.C. here.
