### Washing, Ironing Hints Listed For Christmas Cloths

Bright red or green tablecloths add a gay note to your holiday table if they are crisp and freshly laundered.

To restore their brightness after a year's storage, wash in lukewarm or cool water, suggests Bernice Strawn, extension home management specialist at Oregon State College.

Wash in any mild soap or detergent to protect colors, she advises. Light-duty liquid detergents, which dissolve easily in cool water, are also recommended because they do not fade the dye.

To remove grease spots from the cloth, rub area where spots appear with undiluted light-duty liquid detergent before washing. If dye is colorfast, wash with other colors. To test for colorfastness, dip a corner of the cloth in warm water. If the fabric "bleeds" color, it isn't colorfast. When in doubt, wash separately by hand.

It's always a good idea to save any washing and ironing instructions included on labels when purchasing tablecloths and placemats.

For faster, easier ironing of large cloths, sheets and men's shirts, a wide ironing board is suggested. Some boards are now made with extensions for added ironing surface, or a homemade extension can be easily made from plywood and padding, says the specialist. Place a piece of one-half inch plywood, 48 by 22 inches, over the regular ironing board. Pad well.

Iron dark-colored fabrics on the wrong side to avoid iron marks. Fold large cloth once and roll on long cardboard mailing tubes to prevent creases in the cloth before it goes on the table.

Celery tops may be drained in a fast-warm oven and then used to give flavor to soups.
