Nikita Blasts Reich Chief

MOSCOW (AP)—Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev lashed out Saturday with a bitter attack on West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer.

It was contained in a note replying to an Adenauer communication of Aug. 27.

The latest note was made public at a news conference in the Soviet Foreign Ministry as Adenauer was meeting in Paris with President Charles de Gaulle and British Prime Minister Harold Macmillan.

The criticism was contained in a letter addressed to Adenauer last Oct. 15 but released today apparently to coincide with the Paris meeting.

In his letter, Khrushchev said it was hard to reconcile talk of peace with the action of West Germany in accepting rocket armament for its forces and making the territory of the West German Republic available for foreign rocket bases.

"Suspicion naturally surrounds people who pour gasoline on a people while claiming they are doing so in the interests of fire prevention," Khrushchev wrote.

VANGUARD RADIO DIES

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Radio transmitters in the Vanguard III satellite died last Friday after functioning for 85 days, it was announced Wednesday. The satellite, launched Sept. 18 as the last in the Vanguard series, is expected to continue in orbit for as long as 40 years.
