

4 years

Show him four blocks and ask him how many there are. He can count them fine.

Draw two lines, one twice the size of the other, and ask which is the longer one. He'll point to the right line.

Draw a square on a sheet of paper and ask him to copy it. He'll do the job pretty well.



2 years

Point to pictures of simple things in a magazine. He can identify at least four items such as car, dog, cat, tree, house.

Hand him a book — he'll be able to turn the pages one at a time instead of in sections. He can open a door.
