Young Heavy Scores TKO, Picks Off First Main Event

NEW YORK (AP) — Tom McNeely, sturdy son of a Boston florist, still is an unbeaten young heavyweight with his first main event under his belt. McNeely got off a little easier than expected Friday night when he scored a technical knockout over George Logan of Boise, Idaho. Dr. Alexander Schiff of the New York State Athletic Commission, stopped the bout after he examined Logan's eye cut in his corner after the end of the fourth. Under New York rules that goes

as a fourth-round TKO. McNeely, 196½, dropped Logan, 202, with a left hook in the first round. He said it was the first time he ever knocked anybody down with his left hand. Logan said it was the first time he had been on the deck. McNeely, 22, was pleased about the knockdown. "I've been working and working on that hook," he said in a Boston accent. "My right hand always has been my big punch." Logan, 23, had lost only to Hurricane Jackson in 14 previous bouts. McNeely now has won 16 straight and only two have gone the route.

"Which picture do you want me to use?" Fuller pointed to one photo and said seriously: "That one. He looks more ferocious there." "Well," chuckled Brenner, "That's a picture of your opponent, Logan."
