The fire destroyed seven two-story frame houses, each divided into two units, at nearby Upland Sunday. Seventy-five men, women and children were at home but only one child was hurt. All the residents are Negroes.

Northfork Fire Chief Mike Brown, who fought the fire with only 13 volunteers, said he believed it started in an overheated stove.
