## Red Bluff Bull Sale Set To Go

RED BLUFF — Ever hear of Heartbreak Alley?

It got its name not from disappointed young lovers but from tough, hardened cattlemen. And what happens there often affects your dinner.

Heartbreak Alley is the area at the annual Red Bluff Bull Sale where bulls get their first inspection before qualifying for a closer look by the grading committee.

Hundreds of cattlemen from western states will be here February 4-6 for the annual bull sale and to watch the sifting, grading and sale of 350 Herefords, 86 Angus and 42 Shorthorns, all "Red Bluff Type" bulls.

Can the bull walk properly? This is one of the things which the sifting committee must determine. The bull must spend much of life in rough country and he'll have to be able to get around easily.

If he is found sound of hoof and limb, then the grading committee will look him over.

Each bull must have what judges call "character and masculinity." Each must have ample size for age and should be deep, smooth and thick with plenty of bone and straight hind legs.

His flesh must be in the right places; those places which produce the rib roasts and top quality steaks.

If he has all these qualities, then his offspring should have them too. And that's important to you, because the Red Bluff sale is the biggest of its kind anywhere and most of the West's top range bulls have come from there.

When the committee has completed its work, they stamp a grade on the animal. In the 18 years of bull sale history, only four of the 7,000 bulls sold have been judged perfect. But even a "one minus" bull will bring several thousand dollars. Most of the other 500 animals will sell from \$500 to \$1,000.

### \$60,000 FARM AT FAIR

SYRACUSE, N.Y. (UPI) — A complete farm, valued at \$60,000 will be in operation at the New York State Fair when it opens September 4. The farm will feature a modern home especially designed for rural living, a poultry house, a herd of 25 Ayrshire cows and a shop equipped to make daily machinery repairs.
