In filing, Hatchett said his intention, if elected, would be "to devote unlimited time and energy for better economy in the development of Klamath County." He added, "I believe there should be a greater degree of collaboration between the county court and the city council with civic problems, especially where suburban areas are involved. Other departments of the county should be given better cooperation and certainly more desirable consideration. Above all, it is my assurance to the people of Klamath County to give fair and impartial representation as a public servant."
