Insulin Linked
To Leukemia

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Insulin has prolonged the lives of millions of diabetics but a pathologist says it also may be connected with the sharp increase in leukemia in the last 25 years.

Dr. Daniel Stowens, associate professor of pathology at the University of Southern California, says insulin, as such, is not the cause of leukemia, which is characterized by an excess of white corpuscles in the blood.

But Dr. Stowens says, insulin has enabled millions of female diabetics to grow to maturity and have babies, and it now appears that leukemia, sometimes referred to as blood cancer, is more prevalent in families that have a history of diabetes.

Dr. Stowens' conclusions, which he admits are tentative, are based on 20 years of research with leukemia patients at Children's Hospital in Hollywood. His report appeared Wednesday in a copyrighted story in the Long Beach Press-Telegram.

AUTOMATION TAKES OVER

TRENTON, N.J. (UPI)—Automation replaced a thousand potato pickers in New Jersey last year, the state Agriculture Department has reported.

The department said 37 per cent of the state's potato crop was harvested by machine in 1959. Most of the displaced workers, the agency said, were farm laborers from the southern states.
