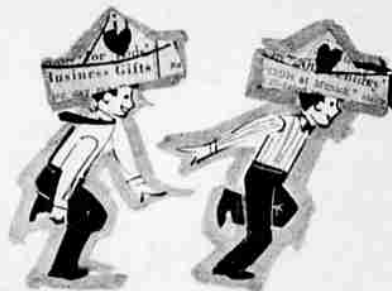

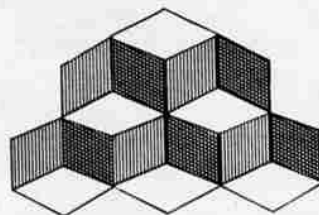

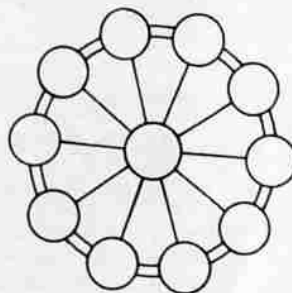
How many blocks can you see? Three? Now turn them upside down and how many can you find?

Miniature Horseshoes

Remove the tops from two rather large tin cans and file off any remaining sharp edges. Pick a shady backyard spot and bury them 15 feet apart so that the tops of the cans are level with the ground. Punch a hole in the bottom of each can for water drainage. Each player uses two large metal washers or rubber Mason-jar rings as horseshoes. Count five points for every horseshoe thrown inside the can and three points for any lying on the ground which stick over the edge of the can. First one to reach 25 points is the winner.

Hearty Words

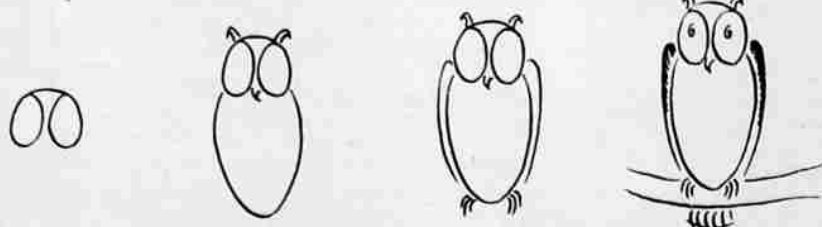
