Russians Favored 8th Winter Olympics Open Today

By MURRAY ROSE Associated Press Sports Writer SQUAW VALLEY, Calif. (AP)—The Eighth Winter Olympics, marred by the usual squabbles, open today with traditional pageantry in this recently developed, 20-million dollar resort in the Sierra Nevada.

The pageantry was under the direction of Hollywood's Walt Disney. There was to be brilliant fireworks, a choir of 2,645 voices, the raising of the flags, the parade of the Olympians, the thrilling moment when the Olympic torch bursts into flame, and the recitation of the Olympic oath by lovely Carol Heiss, the American queen of the figure skaters.

U.S. hopes rest with the figure skaters — world champions Carol Heiss of Ozone Park, N.Y., and David Jenkins of Colorado Springs — and the formidable female Alpine ski squad headed by Penny Pitou of Gilford, N.H., and Betty Sante of Norwich, Vt.

Some 800 athletes from the 30 nations competing will march in their brilliant uniforms with their national flags held proudly aloft in what may be a snowstorm.
