Dunsmuir Nips Weed 53-52 After Seven-Year Drought

DUNSMUIR (Special)—Although the Dunsmuir Tigers finished their Siskiyou League basketball season Friday night in fourth place, they ended it on a happy note by tripping the Weed Cougars 53-52 for the first time in coach Dave Blount's seven-year tenure. The Tigers iced the game with 14 seconds remaining when Tom Loney took a pass from teammate Jeff Hawkins and scored the winning basket with a layup. The lead changed hands several times during the game with the Tigers nursing a one to four point lead most of the way. Dunsmuir led at the end of the first quarter 14-13 and increased the margin to 26-23 at the half. The Cougars dropped off two points from the lead in the third and trailed 40-41 with eight minutes remaining. The Cougars led 52-51 with a minute remaining when Loney dropped in the winning bucket. Tigers' Loney, Hawkins and Murray Crowe played outstanding games. Loney was high with 16, Hawkins tallied 13 and Crowe eight. Doug Blankenship was high for the Cougars with 14 counters. The victors garnered 23-33 at the free throw line and connected for 15 buckets. The Cougars hit 12-20 at the charity stripe and collected 20 field goals.
