### Young Gardeners Offered Scholarships In Nationwide Contest

The Flower and Garden Foundation announced today that it is sponsoring a nationwide "Young America Gardens" contest for grade school, high school and college undergraduates to promote gardening and its pleasures among young America.

The long list of prizes is topped by eleven \$100 college scholarships for hundreds of high school seniors and college undergraduates. In addition, other prizes such as these, are being offered to contestants:

Hundreds of gift certificates good for nursery stock of the winner's choice, roses, clematis, delphiniums, hollies, fertilizer, glad and tulip bulbs, miscellaneous plants, shrubs and trees.

These prizes are being offered through the generous support of firms across the country associated with horticulture in some way. Also offered is a free surprise gift to every young person entering the contest.

Only requirement for contest entry is that every contestant must have a gardening project of his own choosing and doing. For example, he may have a vegetable garden, house plants, rose garden, perennial planting, patio, window box—any project as long as it is of a horticultural nature.

Students must submit a photograph and accompanying letter explaining their particular gardening project, its aims and accomplishments, by the closing date of midnight, September 1, 1960. The project need not have reached completion by that date as long as the letter explains the completion plans and goals.

The contest will be divided among these 3 age groups:

A. Pre-teen up to and including age 12.  
 B. Age 13 through high school junior. (by next fall)  
 C. High school senior and first three years college. (by next fall)

Prizes will also be awarded by geographical area due to regional difference in soil, climate and growing conditions. The areas will be 11 in number, as follows: New England, Mid-Atlantic, Southeastern, West Central, North Central, Heart of America, East Central, Mid-South, Southwest, Far West and Mid-Mountain.

Flower and Garden Foundation is a non-profit institution, devoted to encouraging the youth of the country to become interested in the various phases of gardening. In addition, it seeks to recognize colleges, universities and horticulture and botany departments, or

individuals who contribute to the improvement and betterment of horticultural products and processes.

Entry blanks and a free surprise gift for each contestant may be secured from the Flower and Garden Foundation, Rosedale Station, Kansas City 3, Kansas.

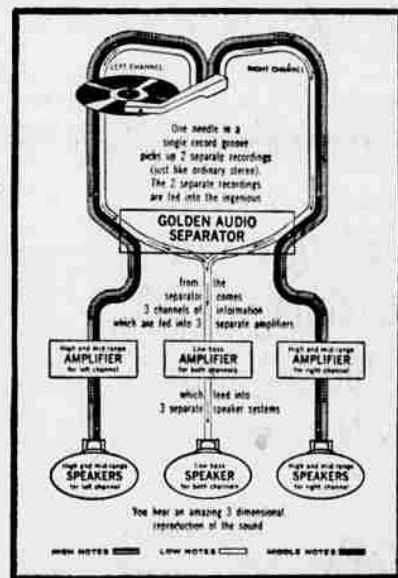

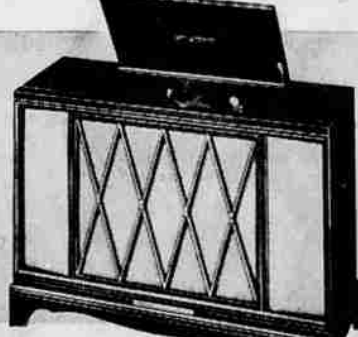
