"The tickets will be \$1,000 a pair," he said. "No one is going to get in for less."

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Butte Valley Womens Club To Enter Test

DORRIS—Mrs. Frank Goldbar, president of the Butte Valley Federated Womens Club, has announced the local club will enter the Community Achievement contest sponsored by National Federated Womens Clubs.

Mrs. Goldbar, in outlining some of the group's achievements, tabulated an impressive list of activities contributing to the growth and welfare of the town and community.

The club has supplied the Dorris City Park with swings, slides, a merry-go-round and other facilities for children. It planted a hedge of roses around the park and helped finance a large barbecue pit and fireplace on the lawn.

The women obtained, and in impressive ceremonies, planted two rare Dawn Redwood trees on the city hall lawn. They furnished a desk and shelves for the Dorris Public Library. As another civic project the members numbered all the homes and business houses in the town.

A rummage sale is sponsored annually at Klamath Falls. Other annual events are the fashion and dressmaking shows, Christmas and other seasonal parties.

As one project in its service to the youth of the community, one club sponsors the local Camp Fire Girls. It also awards a cash scholarship each year to the salutatorian of the graduating class of Butte Valley High School.

Last year, when the Dorris Lions Club sponsored and built a Youth

Center in the park, with cooperation and donations from other organizations, the Butte Valley Womens Club raised \$200 for material not donated for the building. Then, on Memorial Day, when the Lions held a barbecue at the site of the unfinished Youth Center, the womens club, with other organizations, cooperated to help make the occasion a big success. Members cooked food in their homes, carved roasts, made coffee, and did much of the clean-up work.

At intervals, the club holds coffee hours which benefit various community projects. There will be one this week with proceeds going to the Klamath Falls Hospital Fund.

Just last week the club donated more than \$89 to the Lions Club to be used on the Youth Center. Mrs. Goldbar said there are many plans under consideration for an active, fruitful 1960 for the Butte Valley Federated Womens Club.

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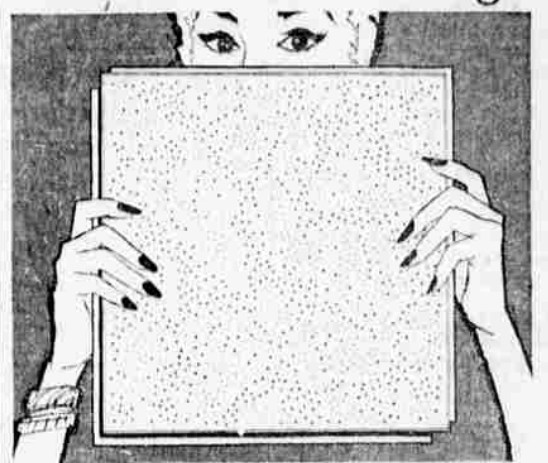
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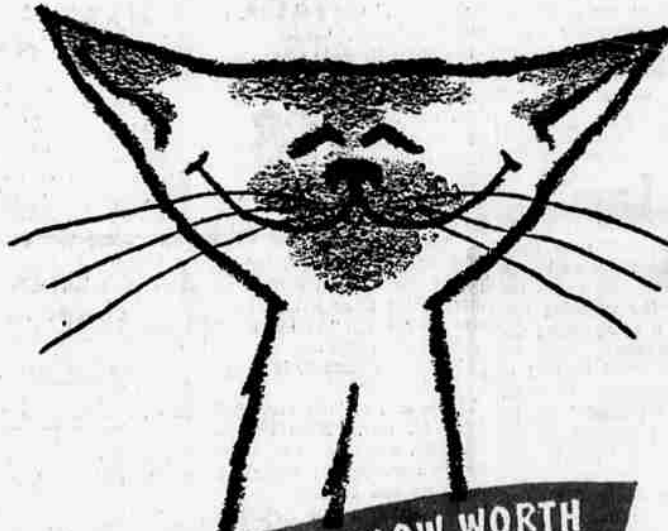
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
