Mom Convicted In Slay Plot

CHICAGO (AP)—A 35-year-old mother of three, crying hysterically, was carried in a chair out of Criminal Court Tuesday after she was sentenced to 60 years in prison for murder.

Mary Saisi was convicted of plotting with her lover the murder of her husband, Peter, 34, an insurance agent, to collect \$24,000 in insurance.

The principal witness against her was Richard Lansing, 23, who pleaded guilty to shooting Saisi and was sentenced to life imprisonment.

GI Turncoats Lose Claims For Back Pay

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Supreme Court today denied prisoners-of-war pay Wednesday to three American soldiers who defected to the Communists after being captured in the Korean war.

In a divided opinion, the court dismissed the petitions of Otho G. Bell of Hillsboro, Miss., and Olympia, Wash.; William A. Cowart, Monticello, Ark., and Lewis W. Griggs, Jacksonville, Tex.

"To allow recovery in these cases would be to put a premium on dishonor and a penalty on courage," the court said.

The court said in its majority opinion, "We do not see how this court, or any court, can construe the law in such a way as to entitle to their pay."

Bell claimed \$1,455, Cowart \$4,991 and Griggs \$2,810 covering the period from their capture in 1950 and 1951 until their dishonorable discharge from the Army Jan. 23, 1954.

A government counterclaim for damages was also dismissed. Judge J. Warren Madden said in a dissenting opinion that the men had incurred "the just condemnation of public opinion," but added: "I think that, according to law, they are entitled to their pay."

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ANTI-SEMITISM RAPED

NEW YORK (UPI) — International affairs writer James P. Warburg Wednesday night called the recent outbreak of swastika-smearing in Germany "a disturbing revival of the dormant and unregenerate Nazi spirit."

Arburg, a former banker, told a B'nai B'rith meeting that this spirit was kept alive both by "a numerically small but by no means insignificant part of the West German population" and "a neo-Nazi or neo-Fascist International."

He said the swastika was a symbol of good luck and was used by many people in many countries.

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\$70,000 Fire Rips Building

PORTLAND (AP) — A strong easterly wind whipped flames through a frame two-story apartment building in a suburban area southeast of Portland Wednesday night.

Members of six families living in the building, which was leveled, escaped unharmed. They lost all personal belongings. Firemen estimated the building loss at \$70,000.

Mel Carpenter, a neighbor, asserted at the height of the fire: "An east wind is blowing and she is burning like a son of a gun."

He told of flames leaping upward from the building. Fire units from both Gresham and Portland had difficulty reaching the blaze because of icy streets.

Firemen were not able to pinpoint the cause of the fire, which also destroyed two cars in an adjoining carport.
