### Local Members Plan Bills For Y 'State Legislature'

Local YMCA Hi-Y and Tri-Hi-Y Club members have prepared two bills for presentation to the "State Legislature" at the 13th annual YMCA Youth and Government Assembly at Salem March 31 through April 2.

The Modoc Chapter of Hi-Y, one of the local YMCA clubs for boys, wants to push through a measure allowing persons jailed for misdemeanors to work for a living while serving time. The Tri-Hi Talamath Chapter, a girls' YMCA club, wants repeal of a state law requiring major party affiliation before a citizen is eligible to vote in primary elections.

More specifically, it is "to acquaint youth with the methods by which we in America determine public policy—that is, make laws—and to help them apply practical Christian ideals to the problems of state legislation." "We want to encourage potential legislators to develop integrity and responsibility rather than skill in clever, tricky and selfish legislative maneuvering." Campbell will accompany the group as supervisor.

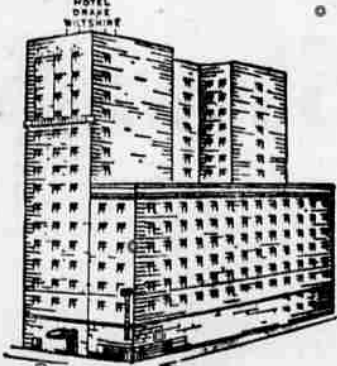
