BAKE IT EASY

NEW YORK (UPI)—When the heat and humidity make cake baking a chore, try this trick with store-bought cake. Melt ½ cup of lemon chips with one tablespoon of butter over hot water. In a small bowl combine 1½ tablespoons of hot milk, ¼ cup of confectioner's sugar and a dash of salt. Add the melted chips gradually, blending well. Pour the still warm glaze over a cake or cookies and spread with a spatula.

Pills Help To Calm Children

DETROIT (UPI) — If teacher complains your child can't seem to sit still in class, a pill might help.

Physicians at the Children's Center of Metropolitan Detroit found that 31 of 40 children between the ages of 5 and 11 who had been almost hopelessly unruly calmed down when given Dextro-amphetamine.

Scientists called their fidgets "hyperkinetic impulse disorder."

"There is evidence that up to two per cent of the school age population from 5 to 11 present this problem," said Dr. Hunter H. Comly, director of the Children's Center.

The Center tried out the drug with the consent of the children's parents, who administered it.

TO CATCH A COP
ROCHESTER, N.Y. (UPI) — A patrolman was the first victim of a drive by Rochester city police to make sure that churches and schools keep their doors and windows locked after hours.
