Loss Limit Change Asked

NEW YORK (UPI)—If you are killed in an auto accident, your heirs might collect as much as \$200,000 or even more in damages. But if you lose your life in almost any international airplane crash, the most your survivors could claim from the airline is \$8,300.

Lee Kreindler, a New York lawyer specializing in airplane damage cases, pointed to this disparity in urging that the ceiling be removed from the liability of airlines operating on international routes.

The United States subscribes to the Warsaw Convention, a treaty which puts a \$8,300 limit on how much an airline can be forced to pay in a damage suit stemming from an international accident.

"Many experienced lawyers," Kreindler said, "feel that the principle of limiting damages for personal injury and death . . . is a totally abhorrent principle and should be abolished from our law."

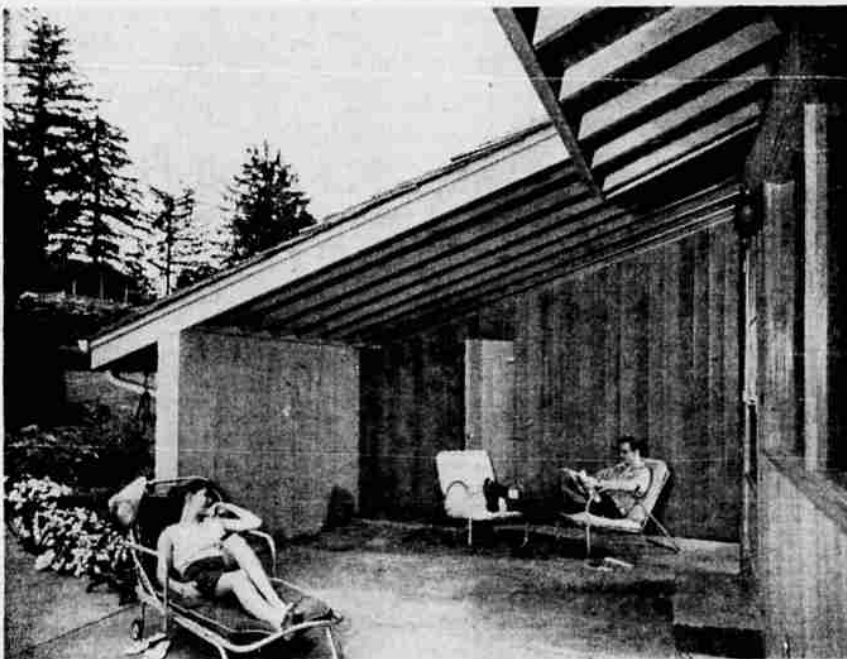

INDOOR-OUTDOOR PATIO — When building a patio, it's a smart idea to plan it for all-weather use. Here, indoor-outdoor patio was designed by simply extending the roof overhang to cover a portion of the patio. With two walls added, patio can be used at any season. Beamed canopy and walls paneled with rough-sawn Douglas fir siding in sandlewood finish give character, livability to area.

Indoor-Outdoor Patio Proves Useful All Year

A favorite feature of many a modern home is the all-weather patio. With a roof or overhead canopy and walls or windscreens, the protected patio caters to lounging year-around.

Especially in the early spring when occasional days of balmy temperatures beckon to winter-bound householders is the indoor-outdoor patio a welcome addition to the home. And mothers find it a real boon, for this spot makes an ideal year-around play yard for rambunctious, under-age outdoor enthusiasts.

The smartest patio design is literally indoor-outdoor. Half is protected on three sides by solid walls and a roof; the other half is open to the elements. This plan is highly practical, not only weather-wise, but also because it serves both the

sun worshipper and the family member who wants to read in a shady outdoor nook.

The all-weather patio should be located where it can share available walls. An L-shaped house, for example, offers two ready-built walls. The L formed by the back of the carport and one side of the house is another good spot. Adding a third wall is no trick at all, but it should match the other stylistically.

Roofing the patio is also a fairly simple job. Most folks merely extend the house roof in an exaggerated overhang to form a canopy for their patio. With exposed beams and decking of a rich wood like Douglas fir.

Patio walls are handsome, too, when sided with a lovely and durable wood like Douglas fir. Many

homes are sided with tongue-and-groove, rough-sawn fir which has been installed vertically. In the all-weather patio, this siding style is delightful, giving the effect of fine wall paneling, especially when finished with a light sandlewood stain which approximates fir's natural golden hue, or with driftwood stain which introduces the timeless beauty of silvery, weathered wood.

You're always a jump ahead if you think in terms of including storage units when planning the indoor-outdoor patio, for this will prove a perfect spot to keep the portable barbecue, sports equipment, and garden tools. Designing one wall two or three feet in depth will do the trick, and it can be tailored with space-saving cupboards and closets to accommodate a world of hard-to-store items. Cabinet doors should be fashioned in vertical fir siding so that, when closed, they blend perfectly with the wall lines.
