

### Senate Filing Almost Missed

SALEM (AP) — There are six candidates for the Democratic nomination to succeed the late U. S. Senator Richard L. Neuberger of Oregon, rather than only five as announced by the state Elections Division after Friday's filing deadline.

Division director Jack Thompson said that in the last-minute confusion the mailed-in filing of Fred O. Like of Seaside was overlooked.

At his home 45-year-old Like said this is his first political venture. He is a motel and service station operator.

In the Democratic primary he joins Neuberger's widow, Maurine; County Judge Harry Fowler of Prineville, R. I. Conn. of Lake Grove, William Murphy of Portland and Daniel Cox of Springfield.

### U.N. Delegation Costly To Tibet

LONDON (AP) — The Dalai Lama's three-man delegation to the United Nations and their American lawyers have cost the Tibetan god-king about \$105,000 in less than a year, a confidential adviser to the exiled ruler reports.

"The most expensive part was American lawyers' fees," D. K. Sen said Sunday.

The U.N. General Assembly adopted a resolution last October expressing grave concern at reports the Tibetan people had been denied fundamental human rights.

### Bombings Bring Death Penalty

BUENOS AIRES (AP) — Plagued by terror bombings, the Argentine government today ordered the death penalty for sabotage.

President Arturo Frondizi signed the emergency decree providing the death sentence for anyone found guilty of acts against the order and peace of the country. He acted after a series of terrorist acts costing a number of lives.

### Alert Arrives In Galapagos

SEATTLE (AP) — An amateur radio operator has reported the 30-year-old wooden vessel Alert and her crew of 32 colonizers has reached the Galapagos Islands safely.

The Island Development Co., sponsors of the 3,300 mile voyage from Seattle to the equatorial islands, said Saturday it received a telephone call from the "ham" operator's father at Palmdale, Calif., telling of the Alert's arrival.

The Alert left Seattle in January. Equipment trouble and winter storms forced the ship to put in at Westport, Wash., and Coos Bay, Ore. She eventually reached Los Angeles where she picked up more colonizers. Thirty-two persons were aboard when she sailed from the California port Feb. 25.

The development firm says the Western Trader is scheduled to leave here later this week with

about 60 additional persons headed for a new life on San Cristobal Island.

The colonizers hope to establish a self-supporting colony by raising crops and farming the sea.

### SHIP LANDS SCIENTISTS

MOSCOW (UPI) — The expedition ship "Ob" landed Soviet scientists on "Peter-The-First Island" in the Bellinghousen Sea of Antarctica recently, the news agency Tass announced Sunday.

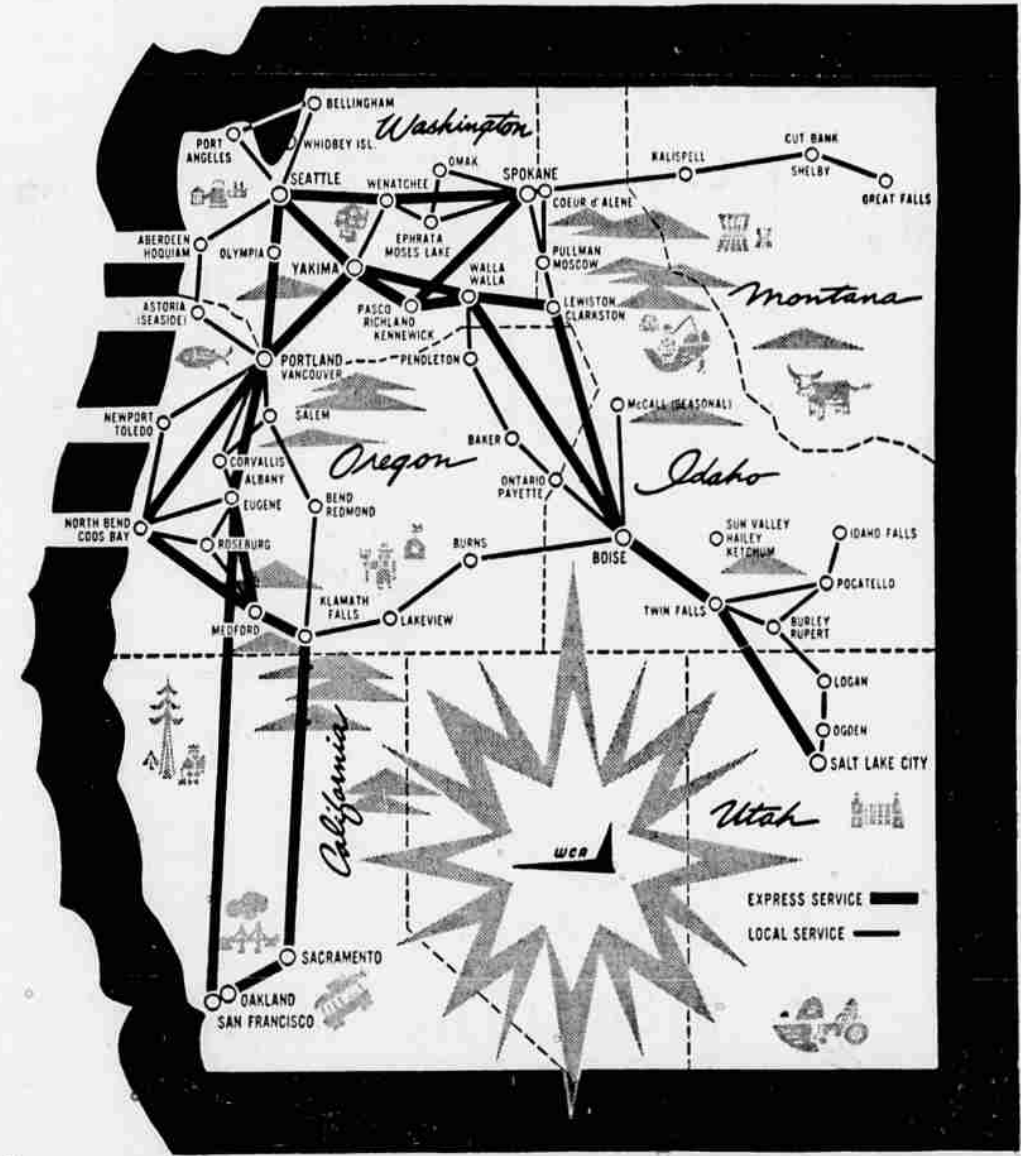
