

Hoffa Ouster Sought By Monitor

WASHINGTON (AP) — The head Teamsters monitor said today that despite lack of cooperation from fellow monitors he will file a batch of new charges seeking removal of James R. Hoffa as Teamsters Union president.

Martin F. O'Donoghue, chairman of the three-man monitor board, said he is requesting permission from U.S. Dist. Judge F. Dickinson Letts to file charges alleging misfeasance and malfeasance in office against Hoffa.

Hoffa already faces trial before Judge Letts April 27 on monitor charges that he misused \$40,000 of Detroit Local 299 funds to help finance a Florida real estate development. Hoffa has denied the charge.

Judge Letts appointed the monitors two years ago to act as overseers of a corruption cleanup in the union.

O'Donoghue spoke out after a series of rapid-fire developments Tuesday. First, Letts denied a move by Hoffa to prevent the monitors from publicizing their complaints and actions. Letts said news reporters are entitled to know what the monitors are doing.

Then the union's designated monitor, Daniel B. Maher, said he is quitting. As reasons, he gave ill health and a feeling that the monitors were only trying to "get rid of Hoffa" and other Teamsters leaders instead of trying to guarantee rights of rank-and-file union members.

O'Donoghue said Maher was right. He said Hoffa had to be deposed if Teamsters members were going to get any rights exercised.

O'Donoghue said Maher and the third monitor member, Lawrence T. Smith, have refused to go along with him in protesting to Judge Letts that Hoffa should be barred from serving both as national union president and head of Detroit Local 299.

Drop Noted In Cancer Of Stomach

WASHINGTON (AP) — A sharp and unexplained drop in stomach cancer in the United States in recent years was reported today by the head of the government's National Cancer Institute. However, he said lung cancer has shown an offsetting increase.

Dr. John B. Heller said stomach cancer is rapidly decreasing both in the number of cases and deaths for both men and women.

The drop is "more spectacular in men because it was the greatest killer in men so far as cancer is concerned," Heller said.

"It has diminished in some areas to the point that it has been difficult for surgeons in some of our studies to find enough stomach cancer cases to run a complete series."

"Offsetting this decrease in stomach cancer, and parenthetically we do not know why this decrease has occurred, has been an increase in lung cancer—a disease which has been increasing about as fast as stomach cancer has been decreasing," he said.

"While over-all our cancer rate is slightly increasing, the mortality rate is slightly decreasing," Heller said. "This means that our survival rate — we speak of survival rate rather than cures—is modestly increasing."

Research activities of his institute, Heller said, "have brought us substantially closer to the goal of full and effective control over this awesome threat to the health and welfare of people everywhere."

He presented to the committee a statement prepared by officials of the National Cancer Chemotherapy program.

"Within the past decade, the idea that cancer might one day be cured by drugs has changed from what might be called a scientific pipe dream to a targeted objective of medical research," the statement said.
