Bomb Hoaxers Get Warning

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Warning to bomb hoaxers: They're going to throw the book at you and the book may get heavier.

There is increasing evidence that authorities are fed up with phony calls that such and such a plane has a bomb aboard.

The airlines have recorded at least 447 such calls for the year 1959, according to a report by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

There were 16 more cases in January and at least 30 more in February and March. Some officials believe the total may exceed 600, including unrecorded calls.

These hoaxes have resulted in untold financial losses to the airlines, inconvenience and anguish to thousands of passengers, and delays to more than 500 flights.

INDIO, Calif. (AP)—The son of a former Olympic swimming star has been sentenced to life imprisonment Tuesday for the bludgeoning slaying of a red-haired Hollywood divorcee.

Tord Ove Zeppenfeld, 21, had pleaded guilty to the murder of Mrs. Lillian Leorak, 42, on a desert road near Palm Springs last Nov. 7.

His mother is Vega Zeppenfeld, former Swedish swimming champion and operator of a Palm Springs motel.

Views Given By Governor

NEW BRUNSWICK, N.J. (AP)—The Republican governor of West Virginia thinks Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey (D-Minn.) has the edge over Sen. John F. Kennedy (D-Mass.) in the West Virginia Democratic presidential primary May 10.

Gov. Cecil H. Underwood said at a news conference Tuesday that Humphrey is better known in West Virginia because of his support of aid to depressed areas. West Virginia has a high unemployment rate.

Underwood is serving a week's stint as a politician-in-residence at the Eagleton Institute of Politics, Rutgers University.

Actress Sheds Bandleader Mate

SANTA MONICA, Calif. (AP)—Actress Mamie Van Doren won a divorce Tuesday from bandleader Ray Anthony.

"He would stay away for months without telling me where he was. Our marriage became impossible," she testified.

Anthony was ordered to pay \$1 token alimony plus \$300 a month for the couple's son, Perry, 4, Miss Van Doren, 26, and Anthony, 39, married Aug. 28, 1955, and separated June 15, 1958.

AF Titan Passes Test

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. (AP)—The Titan has passed its second long-range flight test and the Air Force expects to accelerate its test program to make up for time lost because of a series of failures.

One of the 98-foot intercontinental range giants successfully flew a 5,000-mile course Tuesday. This was the second Titan flight over this range in a month and raised Air Force hopes that it has licked its problems.

A rash of explosions and other mishaps in a 19-month period dating to last May have left the program several months behind schedule.

Officials said Titans probably will be fired at a one-a-week clip to close the gap.

The Titan has a potential range of 9,000 miles. Missiles launched in the current phase of the test program are not fully fueled.
