



TOMATO ASPIC shown here is dotted with cubes of ripe avocado. Celery adds crispness. If the aspic is made in individual molds, try layering it with potato salad or cottage cheese for a red and white salad. Or serve with Dill Cream Dressing. For the dressing, add 1/2 cup diced dill pickles, 3 tablespoons wine vinegar and 1 teaspoon sugar to 1 cup dairy sour cream.

SPRING SALADS

Let's be showmen with our salad!

Let's begin with a sparkling, jewel-like aspic. Insure its ruby-red color by beginning with the finest of tomato juices—better still with concentrated tomato juice, the kind you find on your juicer counter in the convenient, easy-to-carry 6-ounce cans. Processed from choice, low-acid California tomatoes, it not only gives a rich, red color but also a full tomato flavor to your gelatine salad.

Fill the tomato aspic with a second West Coast fruit—mellow, ripe avocado, sliced and folded into the gelatine when partially thickened. Add celery seed to step up the flavor and diced celery for texture contrast. Let the salad jell in a fancy 1-quart mold. Turn it onto a crystal plate, garnish it with twists of lemon and sprigs of watercress or parsley, then make it the focal point of a buffet.

TOMATO-AVOCADO ASPIC
2 envelopes unflavored gelatine
1 can (6 1/2 ounces) Heinz Concentrated Tomato Juice, diluted with 3 cans water
2 tablespoons tarragon vinegar
2 teaspoons minced onion
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1/4 teaspoon celery seeds
1/2 cup diced celery

COTTAGE ASPIC
2 envelopes unflavored gelatine
1 can (6 1/2 ounces) Heinz Concentrated Tomato Juice, diluted with 3 cans water
1 tablespoon minced onion
2 teaspoons lemon juice
1/4 teaspoon celery seed
1 cup cottage cheese

Soften gelatine in 1/2 cup tomato juice. Add remaining juice; heat to boiling. Add lemon juice and next 3 ingredients; mix well. Chill until slightly thickened. Fold in cottage cheese; spoon into individual molds. Chill until firm. Makes 6 servings.

GARLIC BREAD
You can use an ordinary loaf of unsliced bread for making popular garlic bread. Cut the loaf lengthwise through the center but not through the bottom. Then cut the loaf across at two-inch intervals. Spread the cuts with the garlic-butter mixture and heat in a moderate oven.

NEW WAY WITH BEANS
No vegetable for dinner? It can't happen to you if you keep a can or two of blue lake green beans on hand. For variety, cook a half cup of sliced celery and a little instant minced onion in the liquid drained from a can of blue lakes. When celery is crisp-tender, add the drained beans and a lump of butter, and heat thoroughly.

CHEESE

When buying cheese for serving at home, try some of the different types for a change.

There is a cheese for every taste and for every use.

Pizza, for example, calls for a soft cheese which melts readily; mozzarella is the usual choice.

You wouldn't use Provone for macaroni and cheese or scalloped potatoes, probably, but it is excellent grated for a spaghetti-and-meat-sauce dish.

Parmesan goes with so many things. Sprinkle it over soups, salads, pizza, ravioli or buttered crackers to accompany chilled glasses of tomato juice for a pre-meal cocktail.

Don't overlook the various types of soft cheese you see, red-coated and round, in your grocer's cheese cases. There are Gouda-type cheeses, excellent for slicing and serving with raw fresh fruits for dessert or the salad course. Chantelle cheese is a similar type of domestic cheese.

Roquefort and bleu cheeses are great favorites on any cheese tray or for crumbling over salad greens. Try them, too, on piping hot, broiled steak—it is a taste treat.
