Access Road To Be Built

OLYMPIA, Wash. (AP) — The State Highway Commission agreed Wednesday to build an access road to the Washington side of the proposed Biggs Rapid toll bridge provided a contract is awarded for the bridge itself.

The road would be paid for with motor vehicle fund money, at an estimated cost of \$400,000.

The Toll Bridge Authority authorized Monday a \$1,500,000 bond issue to finance construction of the bridge across the Columbia River near Maryhill.

The Seattle contracting firm of Paul Jarvis, Inc., has submitted a low bid of \$2,400,163 to build the bridge. Last month the company gave the state 90 days to complete financing arrangements.

Link With Yankee Flier Denied By Two Brothers

WASHINGTON (AP) — Two Miami brothers mentioned in congressional testimony have denied angrily any link with one of the Americans whose private plane was forced down Monday by gunfire in Cuba.

John Ek, 44, and Robert P. Ek, 43, said they know William J. Sbergalis, one of the downed fliers, but have no business or other connections with him.

The denial came after Immigration Commissioner J. M. Swing told the Senate Appropriations Committee that his department was investigating a possible connection between Sbergalis and the Fidel Castro regime through the Ek brothers.

Swing testified late Thursday before the Senate voted \$300,000 for a stepped-up campaign to halt sneak flights to Cuba. Another \$100,000 was voted to finance Spanish-language radio broadcasts to Cuba to present "the truth of the American position" to the Cuban people. Both sums need House approval.

Swing said his agents had learned that Sbergalis was associated in business with the brother of John Ek, whom he described as a registered agent for the Castro government. Swing suggested by implication that Sbergalis may have made a trip to Cuba last month with the agent under an assumed name.

Swing said Sbergalis was a major stockholder with a rear he identified as Robert Ek Jr. in a Miami firm called Confidential Investigators Inc.

Swing told the senators "I draw no conclusions from all this." He added he was simply giving them the facts.

In Miami, the Ek brothers quickly denied any connection with Sbergalis, whose home is West Hollywood, Fla. They described as "absolutely false" any implication by Swing that either of them made a trip to Cuba with Sbergalis. They said there is no Robert Ek Jr. in their family.

The Eks said Sbergalis now may have stock in a private detective agency John Ek sold more than a year ago.

John Ek said he had no interest in Cuban politics but had applied for registration as a Castro government agent to facilitate his work as a private investigator in locating Cubans who bought but did not pay for automobiles in the United States.

Howard L. Rundquist, Miami and San Rafael, Calif., who was with Sbergalis in the plane, was still being questioned.

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Despised English Killer Commences Life In Jail

BIRMINGHAM, England (UPI) — "I just like beautiful women," said 28-year-old Patrick J. Byrne.

And in his own way, he probably meant it.

Girl friends pictured him as the overprotective type. In particular, he always was worrying about whether some dark, lonely night a sex fiend would get hold of them.

"Paddy used to say he wanted to escort me home at night because I might be attacked," is the way Jean Grant, a girl who used to date the husky laborer, explained it.

"He never once kissed me good-

night in all the times he took me home and never made any advances to me," Jean, a rather buxom blonde of 18, was quick to add.

Byrne today began serving a life term for the sex slaying of a woman.

Other people who knew Byrne used to rib him as being "Paddy the Peeper." The press called him Britain's nastiest murderer since Jack the Ripper. The judge who sentenced him to life in prison Thursday described him as a man under "the influence of overwhelming, violent and perverted lust."

Christmas Eve, had gone to the YWCA room of an unemployed 28-year-old secretary named Stephanie Baird. When he left, a little while later, she was lying dead on a bed, beaten, strangled, mutilated and headless.

The defense lawyers argued vainly that Byrne was insane and guilty only of manslaughter. The jurors found him sane and guilty of first degree murder. British law prohibits capital punishment for murder except in certain cases, such as the slaying of an unarmed policeman.

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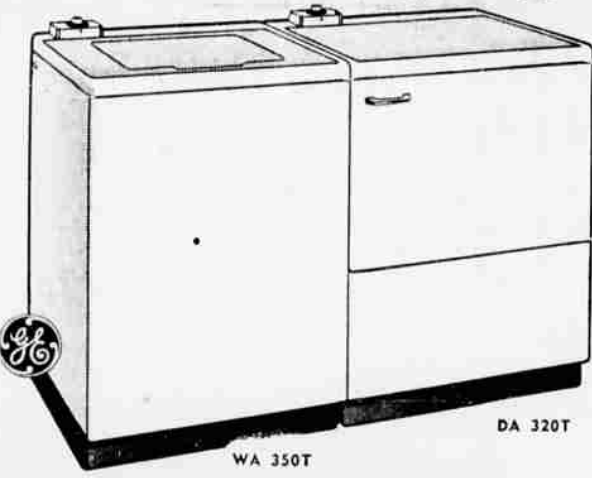
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
