Demand For Big Pay Jobs Reported To Be On Wane

NEW YORK (UPI)—Demand for men to fill jobs with salaries running up to \$100,000 is slipping.
A survey shows corporations need seven-tenths of a man less than they did in the second half of 1959.

This prospect stemmed from the fact that the House Ways & Means Committee was likely to recommend soon an election-year liberalization of Social Security benefits.

Looking Outside
The poll showed more executives being recruited from outside the companies—29 per cent during the past year. Last year's figures showed this group at 29.2 per cent.

Jobs Available
Most of the jobs available pay from \$10,000 to \$20,000 yearly. One-eighth of the total carry a salary of \$20,000 to \$40,000. Some three per cent fall into the \$40,000 to \$75,000 category. The last is twice as good as the previous survey which showed only 1.4 per cent of the jobs paying more than \$40,000.
