

Fences Made Of Wood Give Solid Air To Home

Fences have always done a lot for homes and yards, but they are performing new wonders thanks to the development of pentachlorophenol-type preservatives. With such preservatives ordinary lumber can be used for fences, and this opens up a greater variety of designs than ever before.

It also means that you can utilize the softwoods, some of the

best of which come from the western pine region, in virtually unlimited ways. Designs can become as varied as people's imaginations and the fences can be built with familiar cuts of lumber such as two-by-fours, four-by-sixes, boards of varying widths or perhaps even decking, which is thicker than the average board and fits together tongue and groove

style for a solid flat surface.

For privacy you might want something such as decking or you might make a board fence which could be the simple Tom Sawyer variety or a front and back pattern where your vertical planks are installed alternate on the front and back of your frame. This last gives good protection but lets breezes in and avoids the boxed-

in feeling. Two alternatives are a basket-weave design or an open block-work fence made of sections cut from two-by-fours.

These types all are attractive in gardens because flowers and shrubs look handsome against them and some of these designs lend themselves particularly to vines which can grow up and through them in a very beautiful

way. There are countless variations, however, that lend themselves to construction with the ten species of wood from the western pine region. Some further suggestions are louvered fences, with stationary louvers set into a frame vertically, modified or modernized geometric designs that happen to suit your fancy.

The Western Pine Association suggests that you talk to your lumber supplier and explain to him what your needs are. Often a very simple design will create a dramatic effect while performing its particular function.

Be sure in building any fence, however, to sink your posts well into the ground and on a bed of gravel for proper drainage. All the ends of your lumber should be soaked in your preservative. This is to prevent water absorption and decay in the joints. Also, the tops of all posts should be covered or sealed to prevent absorption of water and subsequent decay. If properly treated and constructed your fence should give years of handsome service and will add that extra "something" to your home.

Lawn Seed Selection Needs Care

Home owners hoping to save money when they seed their lawns this spring may find higher priced grass seed more of a bargain than seed with a low price tag, cautions Harold E. Fennell, Oregon State College extension seed certification specialist.

So-called "bargain" lots of seed often are sold at reduced prices. But if seed is cheap there's probably a reason—poor growth rate, a lot of weeds, a small amount of pure grass seed, or perhaps it's a variety not adapted to the area.

Fennell urged buyers to be extra careful about buying grass seed with much weed seed in it. He pointed out that a seed bag containing one quarter of one per cent (0.25 per cent) weeds—a relatively small amount—has enough to sow five or more weeds per square foot.

Buyers can compare labels on different lots of grass seed to make sure they're getting the bargain they think they are, he said. Labels are required to tell percentage of pure seed, germination (growth) rate, percentage of weed seeds, other crop seeds and inert matter.

Some varieties of grasses grow better in shaded areas than in lawns where there is little shade, Fennell explained, so it is wise to ask the seed dealer or county extension agent about the variety best for your lawn.

If "bargain" seed has a lot of weeds or is not suited to your soil it will cost more in the long run than more expensive seed, Fennell emphasized.
