CHICAGO (UPI)—The successful boss must have a "high frustration level," according to a professor with both practical and academic knowledge in the art of bossmanship.
Ray E. Brown, professor at the University of Chicago's Graduate School of Business and superintendent of its 711-bed clinics, said leaders of men must learn to tolerate human failings and inefficiency.
Describing what he called "the all-or-none complex," Brown said one of administrators' most common pitfalls is the "tendency to attempt only perfect solutions instead of the accomplishable."
"The successful administrator must on occasions tolerate conditions of inefficiency rather than court failure by attempting to clear all obstacles with one great push," he said. "He must determine his goals and evaluate the opposition to them."
