Adlai Dines In Old Home Of Jefferson

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. (AP) — Not in 136 years has the old house seen anything like this. Here in Monticello, the beloved home of Thomas Jefferson, Adlai Stevenson dined in high style Monday night. The last similar dinner according to the curator at Monticello, probably took place in 1824.

"That was when Jefferson — old friend and foe — held a dinner for General Lafayette on one of his return visits to America. After Jefferson's death in 1826 the house was sold and, while entertaining was done, it was on a much smaller scale.

For years now Monticello has been a national shrine, closed at 5 p.m.

Stevenson, the Democratic presidential nominee in 1952 and 1956, is here to make a Founder's Day speech tonight at the University of Virginia, set up according to the plans of Jefferson.

Monday night Stevenson was joined by 21 other guests, some of them students at the university and they ate in a manner as like Jefferson's as can be duplicated in this complicated time.

The place was lit by candles — there's no electricity in the upstairs of Monticello — and the food was brought in from the outside by a caterer. Unlike in the old days, when slaves prepared the meals, the food was passed from hand to hand somewhat in the nature of the old fire bucket brigade from downstairs to the elaborate dining room above.

To a hungry reporter, let in to observe the great occasion but not allowed to share in the food, it was a maddening experience. Course after course was floated in and as Jefferson was a great lover of good wine, each course was washed down with a new delicacy.

It wasn't possible to pick up much of the conversation, which was filled with anecdotes of Jefferson's life. But at one point Thomas J. Macke, Charlottesville mayor, explained that Jefferson had so many visitors drop in to stay for a considerable length of time that he went broke playing host to them.

"Ate him out of house and home," said Frank K. Houston, board chairman of the Thomas Jefferson Memorial Foundation. "Everybody felt sorry for poor old Jefferson — and took it out in drinking wine."

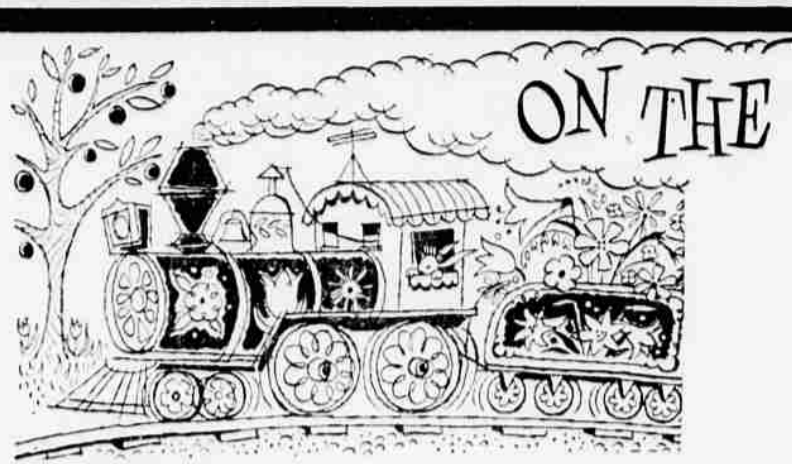

Leukemia Victim, Pope Chat

ROME (AP) — Catherine Hudson, a 7-year-old American girl suffering from fatal leukemia, flies home Wednesday with her fondest wish fulfilled. Pope John XXIII gave her an extraordinary, 40-minute private audience.

"We never imagined anything so wonderful," exclaimed Catherine's widowed mother, Marlene Hudson of Oklahoma City. "The audience was a miracle, a miracle."

Private papal audiences normally are restricted to diplomats and other high officials.

"Through interpreters the 77-year-old pontiff chatted with the dark-haired child and showed her around the little throne room of the papal apartment. Catherine wore the white dress and veil in which she made her first communion a year ago.

The Pope asked about her school and family but never mentioned the illness doctors say will end Catherine's life in little more than a year.
