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Secretaries Get Training

SYRACUSE, N.Y. (UPI) — St. Joseph's Hospital here is trying to ease the nurse shortage by teaching secretaries how to take temperatures, read blood pressure and administer hypodermics.

A spokesman explained that many registered nurses are leaving hospital staffs to work in doctors' offices as secretaries and assistants. The idea of St. Joseph's three-month course is to give young women with secretarial training an education in elementary medical procedures so they can replace these nurses, keeping them available for hospital staffs.

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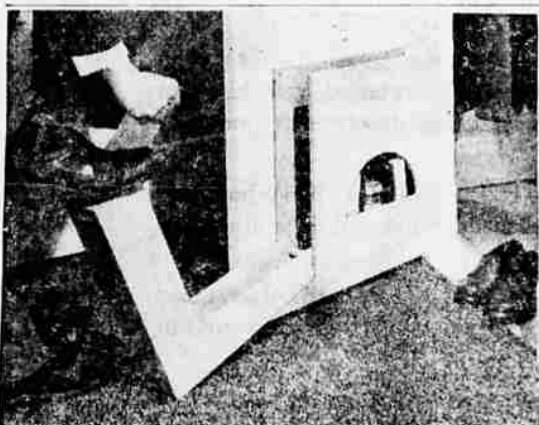
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This handy, lightweight shoe shine kit hangs easily on a closet door. There's no extra weight on the hinges even when it's in use.

Closet Door Good Spot For Shoe Shining Gear

Here's a way to get the shoe-shine equipment out of that junk drawer in the kitchen and out where it will do the most good. The handy shoe shining kit pictured here goes right on the back of a closet door, keeping brushes and polish handy for the moment you discover the bloom has left your oxfords.

One of the problems of putting a unit like this on a door is created by the extra weight the hinges must carry. But even light door hinges are up to this one, built from less than a sheet of thin fir plywood.

The hollow post for supporting the shoe and foot during the shining operation folds away from the

storage unit and rests on the floor, so no extra weight is put on the hinges.

A few simple tools and a minimum of skill are all that are required to build the kit, which can be completely assembled in the basement or garage workshop and then installed on the door. It can be painted the same color as your woodwork, or in a complimentary or contrasting color, if you like variety. There's plenty of room in the storage well for several cans of wax, brushes and polishing cloth.
