**Researchers Tell Program**

NEW YORK (AP) — The Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center of New York has announced an intensive five-year medical, research and teaching war against cancer.

The program, expected to cost more than 125 million dollars, was outlined Wednesday night at a dinner commemorating the 75th year of New York's Memorial Hospital. The hospital is dedicated to cancer treatment and research.

About 86 millions will come from institutional income and anticipated grants from federal and public agencies. The remaining amount will be raised by public subscription.

Ogden White, chairman of the fund-raising campaign, said 11 million dollars already has been pledged. Of this amount, he said, four millions have been pledged by Alfred P. Sloan Jr. and the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation.
