Daily Walk Is Beauty Aid

Walking regularly is an excellent way to tone muscles, and the fresh air will put sparkle in your eyes and a youthful glow in your cheeks.

The right way to walk is briskly, but not at a breakneck pace. When you walk, walk in beauty—head high, chin straight, arms swinging freely. Be graceful about it, though. You're not competing with the army.

To achieve a pleasing walk, it's necessary to wear the proper shoes. Foot specialists recommend leather-soled shoes with broad flat or low heels. The leather sole is light in weight and resilient enough to bend freely with the movement of the foot muscles. The effect is to cut down fatigue in your feet and legs.

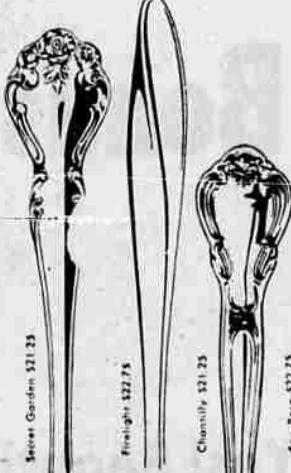
If you plan to visit or shop during your walking tour, you can choose from a variety of dressier walking shoes with low to mid heels in a myriad of attractive styles. Beautiful walking shoes are plentiful this year, with the return of the stacked leather heel. These heels don't have to look broad. Clever design curves the heels in so that they look much more slender than they really are.

Should you find it difficult to get out of the house for your daily walk, try to find a few minutes for some simple exercises designed to strengthen and tone up foot and leg muscles.

Stand in your bare feet and rise up and down on your toes 25 to 50 times. Or try transferring a pencil back and forth from the toes of one foot to the other.

Whatever you do, don't make the mistake of wearing worn-out shoes or flimsy slippers around the house while you work. This kind of sloppiness can cause extreme fatigue at the end of a day.

Wear sturdy low-heeled shoes or house slippers with firm leather soles, and you'll find that you're much less weary come evening. You'll look a lot neater, too.
