

Cooking Contest To Be Featured

MERRILL — A potato foods contest, and miscellaneous, judges will score entries as preparation contest will be a feature of the 24th annual Klamath Basin Potato Festival here October 21 and 22, said Mrs. Lillian Geany, festival contest chairman.

The contest has been a feature each year of the celebration. First place winners in each classification in each division will receive \$1 and a blue ribbon each. Red ribbons will be awarded to second place winners.

Recipes derived from winning entries will be published in next year's Potato Festival program booklet.

Entries will be accepted in the junior division for cooks 18 years of age and under, and a senior division for those over 18. Submitters should be at Merrill High School gymnasium Friday, October 21, by 10 a.m. Entrants are asked to include a typed or printed copy of the recipe used, including names and addresses. All exhibits are to remain on display until 5 p.m. Saturday.

The classes are as follows:

Soups, hot or cold; salads, hot or cold; hot dishes, including potatoes and meat; hot potato dishes to be served with meat (other ingredients may be added); bread, one loaf, white, made with potatoes or potato water; dinner rolls, three rolls to be entered; made with potatoes or potato water; fancy sweet breads (cinnamon rolls, coffee cake and others); cake, light or dark, using potatoes or potato water; cake doughnuts, using potatoes or potato water.

Classes 1, 2, 3 and 4 — general appearance, attractiveness, color, 30 points; texture for type of cooking method, 20 points; flavor, 10 points; suitability, 10 points; recipe, 10 points.

Classes 5, 6 and 7 — general appearance, volume, color of crust-brown and shined, shape, 30 points; texture, 25 points; color of crumb, 10 points; flavor, 25 points; recipe, 10 points.

Classes 8, 9 and 10 — general appearance, shape, volume and crust color, 30 points; texture (tenderness, grain), 20 points; color, 10 points; flavor, 30 points; and recipe, 10 points.
