Storm Topples 25 Trees

CRATER LAKE — A vagrant wind storm here Sunday toppled 25 trees in the residential area at national park headquarters. Three homes were struck and damaged. Most seriously damaged was the home occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Fred Carlisle when a strapping, tall mountain hemlock crushed half its roof. Trees struck homes occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Guy Hartell and Mr. and Mrs. Harold Norris, but damage was less severe. No one was injured, though the Carlises were in their home when the tree came down. Park employees were evacuated to the headquarters shop building to wait out the storm that poured down from the lake rim through a gorge to the headquarters area two miles below from 6 to 11 p.m. The wind was localized. No gusts so severe were reported elsewhere in Klamath County. Families evacuated were the Carlises, Hartells and Norrises and Mr. and Mrs. Rex L. Trulove, Mr. and Mrs. George Woodley, Mr. and Mrs. J. Carlisle and Mr. and Mrs. Herb Gerald. Snow fell in the park over the weekend and was slow in melting this week. Though the depth reached only about two inches on the average, the rim road west

Defector In Seclusion

NEW YORK (AP)—The Estonian seaman who jumped ship from Soviet Premier Khrushchev's liner Baltika has been granted political asylum and turned loose to make a new life for himself in the United States. The defector, Victor Jaanimets, 29, was in seclusion today thinking things out. John Richardson Jr., president of the International Rescue Committee, said: "For a few days, Mr. Jaanimets, in accordance with his own wishes, will have time to rest without being disturbed and to consider his future, to choose his home and to take advantage of job opportunities, and to begin to become an independent American citizen."

Cellist Gives Concert In Rockefeller Home

NEW YORK (AP)—Pablo Casals, world-famed cellist, in what was technically his first New York appearance in a quarter-century, gave a concert Tuesday night in the midtown home of Mr. and Mrs. David Rockefeller. It was a benefit performance. The 100 invited guests contributed an estimated \$70,000 to the September 1961 Pablo Casals international violinello competition in Israel. The competition, held before in France and Mexico, is sponsored by the America-Israel Cultural Foundation. Casals is chairman of the board of judges.
